Tour Indicators/Symbols

- Level 1: Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- Level 2: Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- Level 3: Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
- Guests with Disabilities: These tours are fine for guests with limited mobility or in wheelchairs. Wheelchairs must be collapsible.

Mayan Ruins of Altun Ha

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 2

Travel for approximately one hour from Belize City along quaint country roads to the ancient site of Altun Ha. This site captured world attention when Dr. David Pendegast discovered the now famous nine-and-a-half pound jade head of the sun god named Kinich Ahau in the tomb of the Royal Priest, within the main temple. Three plazas and 13 structures mark the epicenter of this important ceremonial site. Prepared stone steps allow you to climb to the top of three of the main temples.

Note: The drive to Altun Ha is approximately 50 minutes, with the last five miles to the site on bumpy and unpaved roads.

Altun Ha Mayan Ruins & Belize City

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2

This fascinating tour focuses on the contrast between the ancient Mayan city of Altun Ha and modern day Belize City, highlighting 1,000 years of development within this former British Colony. Altun Ha (Mayan for 'Rock Stone Water') thrived as a trading post to the Mayan world during the Classic and Post Classic periods. The site was made world-famous by Dr. David Pendegast of the Royal Ontario Museum upon his discovery of the world's largest carved Jade Head, depicting the sun god Kinich Ahau.

Note: The Belize City tour portion is conducted on a bus without stops.

Cave Tubing & Rainforest Trek

Approximate Duration: 6 ½ hours

Level 2, Meal, Age Requirements

A 37-mile drive along the Western Highway brings you to the Caves Branch River and its winding path, through the Maya Mountains and numerous ancient caves once inhabited by the Maya. Upon arrival at Caves Branch National Park, your headquarters for the day, your guide will issue floats and headlamps while providing a tour briefing. You'll take a 45-minute hike down a jungle trail where your guide will point out various plants, roots and herbs once used by the ancient Maya for medicinal purposes. Next, reach the entrance tunnel that heads into the underground cave system for the start of an eye-opening adventure. Then, float with gentle currents through the cave system. Enjoy intricate crystalline formations that line the caves, and the majestic rise and fall of stalagmites and stalactites that add to the serene opulence of nature. On several occasions, you'll emerge into the sunlight, only to enter into another cave system. Finally, your tubing tour will end where the hike began. You'll return your equipment and head back to Belize City and the ship. On your way back to the docks a stop will be made for lunch.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and able to swim. The cave system and its waterways may cause claustrophobia in a very small percentage of guests. Wear suitable footwear for muddy, wet trails. Bring your swimsuit.

Altun Ha & Olde Belize River

Approximate Duration: 6 ½ hours

Level 1, Meal

A tender transfer to Belize City and an enjoyable boat ride take you several miles inland by way of the scenic Old Belize River. En route you may see iguanas, several varieties of birds, crocodiles and howler monkeys. At Burrell Boom, a quaint settlement on the riverbank, you'll be served a tasty local lunch with refreshments at The Olde River Tavern, located on the banks of the Old Belize River. You'll then board your tour bus and drive to Altun Ha (Mayan for 'Rock Stone Water'), where Dr. David Pendergast of the Royal Ontario Museum uncovered the famous jade head Kinich Ahau.

Note: Boats are exposed to the elements.

Wildlife Adventure

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 1, Meal

After a brief tender ride to Belize City, you'll board a motor launch for a guided tour of the Old Belize River. On this scenic waterway, look out for crocodiles, howler monkeys, iguanas and other wildlife. Some 20 miles upstream, you'll disembark at The Olde River Tavern for a tasty Belizean lunch and refreshments. From here you'll then travel by road to Belize's famous wildlife habitat, the Belize Zoo. This facility is home to the endemic species of the region that are cared for in their natural environment behind protective fencing.

Note: Animals in the zoo are not in cages but protected by fences. The zoo is not recommended for wheelchairs, walkers or canes, as it has loose gravel paths. Boats are exposed to the elements.

Lamanai & New River Safari

Approximate Duration: 7 ½ hours

Level 2, Meal

An approximately 45-minute drive up the Northern Highway brings you to Tower Hill, where you'll board a riverboat and head up the New River. While navigating the many little creeks and lagoons, it's easy to encounter hawks, kites and falcons. Dainty jacanas lightly walk on the lily pads while crocodiles bask in the sunlight. At the entrance to the New River Lagoon, the ruins of Lamanai (Mayan for 'submerged crocodile') rise into view. As you tour the site, huge masks depicting dead rulers and gods seem to materialize out of the rainforest, amid the chatter of birds and the haunting call of the howler monkeys.

Rainforest ATV

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

Your guides will brief you on safety procedures and provide safety gear before heading out to explore the jungles of Belize. See the caves used by the Maya thousands of years ago and be on the lookout for ancient ceramic pots. Afterwards, you'll loop back via jungle trails. Turn in your equipment and feel free to swim in the refreshing waters of the Sibun River. A snack of fresh fruit, nachos and fruit juice is served.

Note: Participants must be at least 16 years of age and present a valid driver's license at the start of the tour. The trails are a mix of various challenging terrains.

Jungle River Tubing & Mayan Ruins

Approximate Duration: 6 ½ hours

Level 2, Meal, Age Requirements

Following a one-and-a-half-hour scenic drive, you arrive in the jungle for your Mayan adventure and a brief orientation. You'll board an exciting safari ride and travel down a rainforest trail on your way to the river. Lie back on your tube and let the gentle current take you down the river. Keep a look out for iguanas, exotic birds and other wildlife living in the towering fig trees above. Stop for a refreshing dip in one of the river's crystal-clear swimming holes and emerge in the midst of an ancient Mayan tomb site, Hubelna, perched on a hill overlooking the river.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and in good physical condition. Wear suitable footwear for wet, muddy and uneven surfaces.

Airboat Adventure & Belize City Tour

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 1, Age & Weight Requirements

Enjoy a narrated city tour highlighting the history of Belize, from its founding by shipwrecked British sailors in 1683. Pass by St. John's Cathedral and other interesting sites. Just outside the city, under a Mayan thatched palapa longhouse, you'll receive an orientation and safety briefing before boarding a 450-hp airboat. Travel to the beautiful Almond Hill Lagoon where you find the manatee grazing grounds. Upon reaching your destination, you'll quietly drift, keeping a lookout for the docile manatees that utilize the area. Pass through Indian Creek onto the pristine marsh to see beautiful water lilies, many colors and varieties of wading birds, turtles and maybe even a crocodile.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age and weigh no more than 290 lbs.

Beach Break

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

What's better than relaxing, working on your tan, or swimming at the beautiful secluded beach of a Belizean island? Board your tender for a short voyage to the island. Once at the beach, it's time for some sun and fun, swimming or just relaxing under a coconut tree, watching or participating in a game of beach volleyball. If you feel up to it you can take part in the 'Tug of War' and challenge the staff. The swimming area is supervised by a lifeguard and there is also a children's play area.

Note: Complimentary use of volley ball and Frisbees are included. For a small additional charge you can enjoy unlimited use of our 25-foot water trampoline, kayaks, paddle boat, catch ball and swing ball. Snorkeling is available for an additional charge. We recommend you bring your credit card and cash for rentals and the restaurant.

Reef Bottom Fishing

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

This excursion is fun for the whole family. There are lots of snapper and grouper, not to mention barracuda and other reef fish waiting to give you a fight! Deck hands will be onboard to ensure all you have to do is fish. They will bait your hooks, remove and mark your catches, un snag your lines and even help you fight the big ones if you snare one.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Bring sea sickness medication if needed. Smoking is prohibited on board the vessel.

Lost World Canopy & Rappelling

Approximate Duration: 5 ½ hours

Level 2, Meal, Age & Weight Requirements

Enter a cavernous tunnel which leads to a primeval rainforest encircled by crevassed rock walls more than 100-feet tall, for your canopy tour of the Lost World Cave. There are five zip lines, ranging from 100-500 feet in length, taking you across the fallen ceiling of this enormous pre-historic cave. Your internationally-trained guides will outfit you with your helmet, harness and gloves and provide you with a detailed safety briefing. Soar from platform to platform like Tarzan and Jane, high above the floor of the densely populated forest. Your last traverse takes you to a rock ledge protruding from the side of the large tunnel-like entrance into the cave, ending with a rappel to the floor.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and weigh no more than 265 lbs. Wear comfortable clothing that you do not mind getting a little dirty. Closed-toe shoes are recommended, although strap-on sandals are acceptable. We recommend you bring a small backpack or fanny pack. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women.

Shark Ray Alley & Ambergis Caye

Approximate Duration: 7 ½ hours

Level 2, Meal, Age Requirements

Board your speedboat for a one-hour journey northeast to Hol Chan Marine Reserve and famous Shark Ray Alley. Snorkel and enjoy the crystal-clear waters and spectacular colors of Belize's Barrier Reef. Reef fish, including snappers and jacks, dart in and about graceful stingrays and the inquisitive brown nurse sharks. Afterward, you'll be transferred to the town of San Pedro for refreshments and lunch. You'll even have time for a little shopping and walking the sand streets of Belize's most famous tourist Mecca.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. We recommend you bring a towel. This tour is not recommended for non-swimmers.

Aerial Trek & Cave Tubing

Approximate Duration: 6 ½ hours

Level 2, Meal, Age & Weight Requirements

The zip line tour features an intricate harness system of pulleys on horizontal traverse cables, which let you swing 100 to 124-feet between platforms and 70-feet high in the trees, at canopy level. The first two hours are spent flying through the forest with the birds. Your next adventure is cave tubing. Be prepared for a 45-minute hike down a jungle trail to the underground cave system. Your guide will hand out headlamps and you'll jump in for a leisurely float on an inner tube, with the gentle currents taking you through the cave system. Observe intricate crystalline formations line the cave, including the majestic rise and fall of stalagmites and stalactites.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and weigh at least 95 lbs. and no more than 350 lbs. The cave system and its waterways may cause claustrophobia in a very small percentage of guests. Not recommended for pregnant women. Wear a swimsuit, tennis shoes (which will get wet) or water shoes and bring a towel.

River Safari, Caves & Beach

Approximate Duration: 5 ¼ hours

Level 2

Depart Belize City by motorcoach to Peccary Park in the nearby village of Gracie Rock. At Peccary Park, you'll enjoy a snack and have leisure time for a swim in the refreshing waters of the Sibun River. You'll then board 'The Crock', our amphibious vehicle, for a leisurely tour of rainforest trails and caves once inhabited by the Mayans, jungle rivers, and swamps to arrive at the Northern Lagoon Beach. Here, you'll have a little leisure time before boarding a river boat back to the Belize City docks. This tour is ideal for viewing wildlife in their natural habitat. Be on the lookout for various bird species and monkeys overhead.

Jungle Bike Adventure

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Meal, Age & Weight Requirements

The Jungle Bike Adventure is an hour of wonder and discovery as you venture into the Belizean tropical forest on hardy trail bikes. Imagine the thrill of biking along a quiet trail winding through savannah thicket and perhaps finding an armadillo family, or riding through the riverside forest and looking up at the majestic Royal Palms towering over you, and with a little luck seeing black howler monkeys feeding on flowers and fruits. After lunch you can enjoy a swim in our exotic swimming pool with a sculptured waterfall/waterslide, or just relax in one of our many hammocks.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age. Maximum weight is 250 lbs. Approximate bike riding time is one hour. You must know how to ride a bike and be in good health. Pregnant women are prohibited from riding bicycles. Wear a swimsuit, sunglasses, hat, towel, sunscreen, insect repellent, and wear closed-toe shoes.

Bacab Jungle Park

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 1, Meal, Family Recommended

Your tour starts with a walk through the elevated palmetto boardwalk where orchid and bromeliad-laden trees can be seen. You then enter the Wild Wings Butterfly House, where winding pathways offer the opportunity to view a wide variety of native Central American butterflies in a kaleidoscope of unique colors. Iridescent blues of the Blue Morpho, lime green of the Malachite, and brilliant red, yellow and black of the Postman. The false eye pattern displayed by the Owl Butterfly give credibility to its unique name as it mimics the large staring eyes of an owl. Streams, ponds and waterfalls provide soothing sounds for the visitors and offers moisture for the butterflies and tropical plants. After lunch you can enjoy a swim in our exotic swimming pool with a sculptured waterfall/waterslide, or just relax in one of our many hammocks.

Note: Wear a swimsuit, sunglasses, hat, towel, sunscreen, and wear closed-toe shoes. Insect repellent should be put on after the butterfly tour.

Approximate Duration: 1 hour

Level 2

This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to ride in an authentic offshore race boat. This high-speed powerboat is custom-designed for complete safety and comfort. Experience a thrilling 45-minute ride through Belize's Great Barrier Reef. Be prepared to get wet as you move across the Caribbean Sea at speeds in excess of 50 miles per hour.

Note: Wear a swimsuit and bring a towel.

Wildlife River Rafting

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Enjoy a guided tour on an inflated motorized river raft along the nearby Olde Belize River. On this scenic waterway, you'll see crocodiles, howler monkeys, iguanas, and lots of birds. Turtles, manatees, and dolphins are frequently spotted as well. Lush tropical foliage lines this waterway and several small farming villages dot the riverbanks.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and weigh no more than 350 lbs.

Calypso Train Tour of Belize City

Approximate Duration: 1 hour

Level 1

"All Aboard!" Embark on an open-air trolley train for a fun and informative tour through this former British colony. Relax and enjoy the cool ocean breeze as your guide details the rich history and cultural diversity. See all the important and interesting landmarks such as the Baron Bliss Lighthouse, Governor's Mansion and St. John's Cathedral to name just a few. Enjoy your complimentary local snack and chilled bottled water while you travel through the contrasting districts to see, hear and experience the real hustle and bustle of Belize City today. Return over the famous Swing Bridge, completing your journey aboard the Calypso Train.

Land Rover Jungle Tour

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

This tour offers an opportunity to enjoy the awesome natural beauty of the rainforest, uninhabited jungle rivers and caves once used by the ancient Mayans who inhabited this region. You'll depart your ship on a high-speed boat for the Sabun River. Once on the river, the boat will wind its way upstream along the jungle-covered banks, a sight directly from an Indiana Jones movie. After approximately 45 minutes, the boat will arrive at the Landings, a secluded farm located on a peninsula by the river. You'll have a short break to visit the farm and get familiarized with the 4 x 4 Land Rover which will take you on the next leg of your journey to the Mayan Groto Caves. The Land Rover, which is famous for jungle driving, is the perfect vehicle for the 50-minute drive through the lowlands and into the jungle mud trails. Once at the base camp, your guide will give you local knowledge as he leads your small group on a traverse over a foot suspension bridge across the river. After a short walk through the dense rainforest where many species of huge trees can be seen, you'll arrive at the beginning of the cave experience. The first cave tunnels through the mountain and emerges into a tropical bowl with cliffs on all sides. The Mayans used this location as a sanctuary with protective walls still evident. Within the bowl there are many caves to explore each with different stages of stalactite and stalagmite growth. After caving, you'll have an opportunity to swim in the cool river, relax, and have a snack before boarding a jungle truck for the return trip to Belize City.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age.

Raiders of the Lost Mayan Caves

Approximate Duration: 5 ¾ hours

Level 2, Meal, Age & Weight Requirements

Be prepared for a thrill of a lifetime as you trek your way up a hillside trail through the Belizean jungle, seeking 'Dragons Mouth', the ceremonial entry into the Mayan Underworld. Be ready to experience what you have only seen in the movies; this adventure tour is not for the feint-of-heart. You'll get dirty and wet (only in rainy season) as you travel through different levels of the Mayan Underworld, by way of 'via-ferrata,' zip lines, swinging suspension bridges and an exciting rappel down a cliff face.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and weigh no more than 265 lbs. If you have any previous heart conditions, back or leg problems or are pregnant, this tour is not for you.

Robinson Crusoe's Jungle Survival Adventure

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

What would Robinson Crusoe do if he suddenly found himself marooned in the midst of a rainforest? What would you do? Learn the ingenious survivor skills and secrets to managing this kind of a situation from instructors who have done such things first hand! Your experienced jungle guides will teach you how to make fire using only a machete and a piece of Bamboo. Learn to identify sources of water and how to actually produce it. See jungle traps in action as they ensnare and ensure your food supply. Then visit Robinson Crusoe's jungle-style dwelling made from all natural materials – vines, branches and the bark of various trees.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age.

Jungle Resort Horseback Safari

Duration; 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Meal, Age & Weight Requirements

Enjoy an hour of fun-filled excitement as you discover the Belizean tropical forest by horseback. The trail winds through a gallery of royal palms as parrots nesting up near the fronds call out across the forest, the harsh sound temporarily obliterating the sounds of other forest birds. In the high canopy of intertwining branches of guanacaste trees, bullet trees, tarpon blossom and bukun tees, one or more troops of black howler monkeys might fill the air with their deep resonating roars, defining their territory while sunning iguanas lazily and nonchalantly gaze across the river to treetops filled with more iguanas. Then, make your way to your lunch spot where a delicious buffet lunch will be waiting for you. Last, relax and take a refreshing swim in the middle of the jungle in the beautiful exotic pool with a sculptured water slide.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and weigh no more than 250 lbs.

BELIZE DIVE IN™ TO ADVENTURE

Turneffe Atoll Two-Tank Dive

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, C-Card

Belize boasts three of only four atolls in the Western Hemisphere; the Turneffe Atoll is the largest. This creates a natural nursery with abundant marine life. The atoll ensures the ability to dive regardless of the wind direction, as dive sites are available on either side of the atoll to provide an always 'lee-side' situation for comfort and safety. Two dives will be made with an average depth of approximately 60-feet on the first dive and approximately 50-feet on the second dive. The coral formation is typically a spur-and-groove formation, with the top of the reef being approximately 35-40 feet with a wall to more than 100-feet, with a shelf and additional wall drop.

Note: Equipment is not included but is available for rent.

Discover Scuba Diving

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

For those who have always wanted to Scuba, now is your chance. You'll proceed to a private 186-acre island for a brief training session on the principles of Scuba and use of equipment. Then it's off to the Barrier Reef for your Scuba diving adventure and the opportunity to see exciting marine life. Fresh fruit, juice, and purified water are available throughout the excursion.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and able to swim. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Boat Blast & Snorkel

Approximate Duration: Varies

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Upon arrival at Uvero Beach you'll be given your safety equipment and an orientation. Your first destination will be the amazing reef that parallels the coastline. Jump in and discover the unspoiled beauty of the reef system. Back on your speedboat you'll head to Uvero Beach where you'll be given the opportunity to stay and enjoy numerous non-motorized water sports as well as an open bar, or be taken back to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, weigh no more than 240 lbs. and be in good physical condition. Shuttles return to the ship every 60 minutes.
