Deep Sea Fishing

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age & Weight Requirements

Do you want to experience deep-sea fishing in Bermuda? Well this is the tour for you. Bermuda is known as one of the premier sport fishing centers of the world. Many of the International Game Fishing Association's world records were established here. Fishing is at its best from May to November. Depending on the month, blue marlin, Wahoo, tuna and dolphin are plentiful. An experienced Captain and crew will accompany you during your trip.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age, weigh between 80-350 lbs. and be in good health. Bait and tackle, and boxed lunch with beverages are included. There is a 4-person minimum per boat requirement. Off-shore fishing, by its very nature, will be further away from the protection of the land. Rolling and pitching may be encountered during the trip. Guests should be aware that there may be rough sea conditions. Due to Health and Safety regulations you are unable to bring your catch onboard.

Hartley’s Helmet Dive

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

No lessons or swimming skills are required. At the reef, you’ll climb down a nine-foot ladder to the ocean bottom. Once at the ocean bottom your ever-present guide will point out and identify marine life like Diana the angelfish, Charles the hogfish, Franklin the golden-tailed moray eel, and Oliver the grey snapper. Your dive will take approximately 30 minutes, and will allow you to enjoy the magnificent coral scenery. Upon conclusion of your dive, enjoy a scenic boat trip back to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age. Wear your bathing suit and bring a towel. We recommend you bring a dry change of clothes. This tour is not recommended for guests with breathing difficulties or claustrophobia. Complimentary refreshments will be offered. Dry snacks will be available for purchase.

Captain’s Select Snorkel

Approximate Duration: 3 ¼ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

A wonderful adventure waits aboard this custom-built snorkel boat. Its professional crew will take you to a shallow reef and sandbar for your first stop. The crew will give a full snorkel and safety briefing, along with additional instruction for anybody who is new to the sport, or just out of practice. After the briefing, plunge into the underwater world and explore the shallow reef site. Many juvenile species of fish and coral occupy the coastal area, and it’s a wonderful location to master the art of snorkeling. You’ll have approximately 45 minutes to explore the calm waters. The boat will haul anchor and cruise out to the second snorkel site, a beautiful fringed coral reef located off the north shore. This reef will be in slightly deeper water, but that’s OK, you’ll of course be equipped with flotation and all the new found skills you developed at the first site. This reef offers a greater variety of fish and coral that you won’t find on the shallower beach and coastal locations. You’ll have up to 45 more minutes at anchor, where you can snorkel the time away, sunbathe on deck or hit the onboard bar. Following this snorkeling time, you can kick back, relax and enjoy some music and cold beverages on the way back to your ship.

Note: Participants must be in good physical health, with no physical handicaps that prevent walking up or down a dive ladder without assistance. This tour is an opportunity to learn to snorkel, or refresh your skills, in a safe and controlled environment. Participants must be at least 18 years of age to consume alcohol. A valid photo I.D. is required. Cash bar available onboard. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Your air-conditioned coach will depart the ship's pier at the Royal Naval Dockyard to explore the West End. Cross over Somerset Bridge, the smallest drawbridge in the world, connecting the mainland with Somerset Island. Stop at the famous landmark Gibbs Hill Lighthouse, 120 feet above sea level which allows for superb views of the many islands at the base of the lighthouse. Visit Church Bay – a snorkelers' paradise, and Horseshoe Bay's wide crescent of soft pink sand. At the east end of the island is the historic and quaint old town of St. George's, a World Heritage Site characterized by its picturesque cottages, quaint lanes, cobblestone streets and alleyways. You'll have 45 minutes to explore on your own before boarding the coach for the rest of your tour. On the return back to your ship, enjoy the sites of the north shore. In addition, see and hear about the 'Old Rattle and Shake', the now deserted Railway Trail that once ran from one end of the island to the other. The City of Hamilton, the hub of international and local business on the island, is next on the tour. A drive through Bermuda's capital, allows you the opportunity to get a feel for this thriving center, before exiting en route back to your ship.

They are home to an abundance of coral and fish and they are situated on the very edge of the surrounding reef. The captain will give you a history on Bermuda and some of its shipwrecks. Upon arrival to the site, you'll be issued with snorkel equipment and given a safety briefing on how you may best enjoy up to one hour of safe snorkeling. Finally, enjoy complimentary Rum Swizzle and soft drinks on the return trip to your ship.

Most of these wrecks are situated in relatively shallow depths of 30-50 feet. After being briefed on safety instructions, your first dive will be to a historic wreck in 50-80 feet of water. Your second dive will be to a breathtaking reef where coral and colorful fish are abundant. A relaxing cruise back to land completes the perfect Bermuda dive.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, weigh no more than 250 lbs., and a certified diver. Participants must be in good health. Due to restrictions by the Dive Provider, any Scuba participants currently taking any medication or with a previous medical condition should bring a note from their primary physician stating that they are medically cleared to participate on a Scuba excursion. The other half of the program takes place in the deeper water where you are observing the dolphins swimming under and around you, having a chance to see them through a mask and experience more interaction. Tour price also includes admission to the Maritime Museum where you'll have time to browse in addition to time with the dolphins.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women. The Dolphin Dip takes place within the walls of the Maritime Museum. On adjacent St. David's Island, you'll discover the charm of this enchanting community, once occupied by the former Base Lands of the US Navy. A picture stop is included at St. David's Lighthouse, which stands on the highest point on the eastern tip of the island, sending its beam 20 miles over the ocean. Your tour will continue along the island's coastline, passing the island's oldest limestone house, Carter House, and top beaches of the east end of the island, Clearwater and Turtle Beach. The tour will end at the cruise ship terminal and includes your round-trip ferry ticket from the cruise ship port, Dockyard.

Pulley created a magnificent, contoured layout that maximizes the golfer's experience while showcasing the Island's captivating beauty. Panoramic views of Hamilton Harbour and the Great Sound provide the backdrop for some of the finest 18 holes on the Island. Belmont Hills' greens are built to U.S.G.A. standards and sprigged, naturally enough, with Tiff Eagle Bermuda Grass. The fairways feature 419 Bermuda grass to provide the best possible playing surface. And although Bermuda has its fair share of sand, Belmont Hills' bunkers hold the same sand Master's players try to avoid at Augusta National. Water hazards come in to play on several holes, which is unusual for a Bermudian course. (Bermuda doesn't have any natural creeks or rivers and only a handful of freshwater ponds). Two large man-made ponds complement the dramatic rolling landscape. An automatic irrigation system keeps tees, fairways and greens; including Bermuda's only double green (14,000 square feet), in peak condition. Hundreds of trees have been planted or relocated to define the fairways and to increase safety. Our course is waiting for you. Come and play.

Riddell's Bay Golf Club

Riddell's Bay Golf & Country Club, opened in 1922, is Bermuda's oldest golf course. Winding along a beautiful peninsula, these scenic links provide golfers with a magnificent challenge to both game and camera. The course was originally designed by architect Devereux Emmett who, shortly afterwards, built the Congressional near Washington, D.C., the site of the 1997 U.S. Open and has been most recently improved by both Robert Trent Jones and his son, Rees Trent Jones. It is gradually acquiring a new look and has upgraded all of the equipment, product and golf balls. While Riddell's Bay may not pose the sternest test on the island, in part due to its relatively short length, it is still an enjoyable test for all golfers. Measuring almost 6,000 yards, some of the holes are mapped out on an ocean peninsula that measures just 600 yards at its widest point – this is a truly unique layout. The golf experience at Riddell's Bay is quintessentially private and Bermudian. Proper Bermuda length shorts and shirts with a collar are mandatory for both players and riders.
