Tour Indicators/Symbols

Level 1:	Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
Level 2:	Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.

Philipsburg, St. Maarten

See & Sea

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

This tour combines the best St. Maarten has to offer, both on land and beneath the ocean's surface. Depart Philipsburg on the Dutch side of the island, and drive up the eastern side to the second largest town in St. Maarten – Grand Case. Here you'll board a semi-submarine for an approximately 45-minute narrated tour of the coral reefs surrounding Creole Rock. The highlight of the trip is when a diver is surrounded by schools of fish and dangerous green spotted moray eels. Back on shore, your tour continues to the French capital of Marigot, where you'll have time to explore this attractive port city with its sidewalk cafes, open-air market and duty-free shops.

Note: Participants must be able to walk approximately 100 feet and negotiate 7 steps into hull of boat.

America's Cup Regatta

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

Take advantage of this once-in-a-lifetime experience, the thrill of racing aboard a multimillion-dollar America's Cup race boat. Two classic thoroughbreds nearly 70-feet long with masts the height of an eight-story building, duel in an equal match for a fractional advantage. They round the first mark and head off on the next leg. The race boats slice through the clear blue waters at speeds you have never sailed before. The skippers and crewmembers explain the strategy for winning the race, and you rise to the task! And, as if by miracle, a photo boat arrives to record for posterity

4x4 Jeep® Adventure

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Age Requirements

It's just a short, scenic ride from the harbor to the Village where you and your fellow guests will be assigned to your 4x4 vehicle (4 guests to each vehicle.) The convoy will follow the lead vehicle to explore this beautiful dual personality island. Stops will be made at strategic points and driving responsibilities can be rotated. Highlights will include the scenic Cole Bay Hill, Simpson Bay and the famous Marina, Maho, Mullet Bay and of course the French capital, Marigot. You'll pass by Grand Case, well known as the gourmet capital of the Caribbean and continue on to a popular beach with enough time for a quick swim in the ocean or enjoy relaxing on the beach. After your beach stop you'll continue driving through the countryside driving through the countryside back to the pier.

Note: Participants must be at least 25 years of age and present a valid driver's license in order to drive. Children less than 8 years of age must be in a car seat, which must be pre-reserved at the Shore Excursion Desk on board your ship. This is a self-driven tour. There are 4 guests to each vehicle. All vehicles must remain with the group at all times and any itinerary changes are made only by the guide in the lead vehicle. There is no off-road driving on this tour. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Rhino Rider

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Experience on-the-water excitement with a two-man Rhino Rider; a 10-foot inflatable motorboat that is yours to command. Following your guide, you'll maneuver safely through anchorages for hundreds of boats and alongside mega-yacht marinas before exiting the lagoon into Marigot, the French capital of the island. View historic Fort Louis before continuing along the picturesque coastline to your final destination at Happy Bay. It's your choice whether you hike the trail, snorkel the reef or build sandcastles on the beach – the time is yours to enjoy the beautiful surroundings.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and at least 18 years of age to operate the Rhino. Maximum combined weight is 400 lbs. per boat. Tour is not recommended for pregnant women or those with back problems. Snorkel gear is provided. This tour is on the French side of the island, where some nudity may be observed. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Golden Eagle Sailaway

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements, Family Recommended

Count the flying fish or watch for dolphins while lying in the nets or lazing in the shade. The 'Golden Eagle' will nuzzle her bow into the finest pink-sand beach you'll encounter in the Caribbean. Stop for a swim in a quiet cove, snorkel in crystal-clear waters or bob around on a funky noodle beach float. Homeward bound, the crew sets the sails as you listen to great music while enjoying champagne, rum punch, sodas and light snacks.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age and weigh no more than 275 lbs. Venue may change due to weather. This tour is on the French side of the island, where some nudity may be observed.

Discover St. Maarten Dutch & French

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 1, Guests with Disabilities, Family Recommended

As soon as you depart the harbor you'll start to enjoy the charm and scenery of this dual personality island which has been flying the flags of both Holland and France since 1648. You'll drive from Phillipsburg, the Dutch capital, past Great Salt Pond and through the countryside. The tour then continues past the Border Monument indicating arrival at the French side, into the district of Orleans. Sightseeing continues through several quaint towns and fishing villages, including Grand Case known for its lovely beaches and exquisite restaurants, then across the north side of the island for a short stop at Marigot, the French capital, where you'll observe a truly European atmosphere as you browse its waterside open-air markets, quaint shops, boutiques and sidewalk cafes. After your brief sojourn in Marigot you'll

return to the Dutch side and a truly spectacular view of Simpson Bay as you drive over Cole Bay Hill. Stopping at the Village, you can use the rest rooms and browse. Take the bus back to the pier.

Orient Beach Rendezvous

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 1, Meal

A short drive from Dutch St. Maarten brings you to one of the trendiest beachfront restaurants at Orient Beach, in French St. Martin. Critically acclaimed as the French Riviera of the Caribbean, the beach offers more than one-and-a-half miles of white-sand fringed by coconut palms and sea grape trees. A welcome rum punch or soft drink is served upon arrival and a delicious lunch, including a beer, wine, soda or mixed drink, is served at tables on the beach. Lounge chairs are complimentary and umbrellas are available for rent.

Note: Orient Beach is a European-style, clothing-optional beach. A credit card is required for water sports equipment rental. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Natural Wonders

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 2, Guests with Disabilities

Experience the full beauty of natural St. Maarten on a tour that takes you on a journey of discovery. After boarding your air-conditioned bus at the dock, make the scenic trip to some of St. Martin's best ecological attractions and areas. Travel along Philipsburg's natural salt ponds as your guide provides interesting information regarding the importance of the salt ponds to the eco-system. Then arrive at the St. Martin Park where a guide will introduce you to some very unique residents, including an amazing array of parrots – blue and gold, green-winged and scarlet macaws. See the Caribbean and American tropics come alive, with 80 species of mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians and invertebrates displayed in a tropical, garden setting. After enjoying a beverage at the Monkey Bar, your tour continues through the mountainous middle region, and heads for the area of Oyster Pond. Along this picturesque eastern coastal road, you can view St. Barth's, Tintemarre, and the many smaller islets that dot the Caribbean Sea. A brief stop allows you to climb a small wooden lookout at Baie D'Embouchure. Your guide will discuss the environmental importance of the reefs and the mangroves that can be seen from this area before heading back into the interior, passing mangrove colonies along the way. Your well-informed guide will continue to point out interesting facts about the island's flora on fauna including the interesting medicinal use of island 'bush tea'. Your tour continues on and skirts the eastern shore of Simpson Bay Lagoon before starting back towards Great Bay. From the vantage point at the top of Cayhill, the islands of Saba, Statia, St. Kitts, Nevis and Anguilla are all visible. Enjoy a brief photo opportunity here as your guide discusses the geological details of St. Martin including the history of its formation millions of years ago. You'll then head back to Philipsburg, passing Belair Fresh Pond which is fringed with mangroves and home to 19 species of Avifauna.

Note: Wheelchair access may be limited – for details, please consult your Shore Excursion staff before booking. Wear comfortable walking shoes.

Ultimate Island Tour & Explorer Cruise

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Meal, Age & Weight Requirements

The 'Explorer' catamaran features vast sundecks and shady areas with two bars offering unlimited complimentary rum punch. Cruise through Simpson Bay Lagoon, Port de Plaisance Resort and Palapa Marina. Take a peek at the homes of the rich and famous as you listen to great calypso tunes while sailing. Arrive at Marina Royale in the heart of the Marigot shopping area. After shopping, you'll be taken on an island tour with your driver/guide detailing the history of the island and pointing out places of interest as you wind your way past Grand Case, French cul de Sac and Orient Bay. Make a short stop at a lookout for a breathtaking view of the northern side of the island and then head back past the French Quarter to the Dutch Side. Finally, you'll arrive back in Philipsburg, where you'll be able to visit the Front Street shops or return directly to your ship.

Shipwreck Cove Snorkel & Shopping

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

Your trip starts by being escorted from the gangway down the pier to a gem of a catamaran. You'll sail to a splendid snorkeling spot and discover underwater life or just relax on the boat. It's up to you. Next, sail to the shopping Mecca of Philipsburg. The Dutch capital has only two main streets, but it's packed with duty free shops and the Caribbean's top bargains on liquor, linen, international fashion, watches and jewelry. While sailing back to Philipsburg a light snack will be offered. Upon arrival at the town pier you are now free to do as you wish. Sit and tan or hit the shops along Front Street. Earn your Black Belt in "retail therapy", and then unwind at the beach with your ship in the distance. Again, the routine is unstructured and you set the pace. Do nothing or do everything Philipsburg has to offer. You're free to return to the ship on your own whenever you like, with supplied "water taxi" bracelet.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and good swimmers. Wear your bathing suit and bring a towel. Return to the vessel is at your leisure. Entry into the water is directly from the craft and participants must be able to get on and off catamaran and into water unassisted. Swimming is your own risk at the beach. No life guards are on duty. Protect your personal items. A cash bar is available. Depending upon wind and weather, the vessel may use the motor. A water taxi bracelet is provide and after guests are dropped downtown Philipsburg they are free to return to the ship at any time on the water taxi. Check what time the water taxi stop service.

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 1, Age Requirements

See the island, including a stop in Marigot and a beach for a swim, on the rolling party bus called the 'Macarena Choo-Choo'. Searching for a quiet getaway? Look elsewhere. This is for those who want to travel on a rhythmic road with fearless party leaders. Don't worry, be happy! Enjoy the hot music and cool atmosphere. First stop is the Village for a bit of souvenir shopping. Check out the arts and crafts and local rums. Sampling is fine – you're not driving. Then head to Marigot on the French side, but not until you're wowed by the view from Cole Bay Hill. There's time in the French capital to browse the trendy boutiques and sidewalk cafes. With the fragrance of French perfume lingering behind, the magical madness tour heads along the north-east coast to a specially selected beach for a quick dip in the refreshing Caribbean waters. Then it's more music, as the hits just keep on coming. An appetizing snack will be served during the tour and rum or fruit punch is offered.

Note: Persons under 21 years of age will not be served alcohol. This tour is not recommended for those who do not like loud music. This is not a narrated tour but a fun island drive with music and beverages. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Your host/hostess will also be close by to serve you complimentary beverages throughout the trip.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. This is a catch-and-release bottom-fishing excursion. There is no guarantee of a catch. Guests who are prone to seasickness should take the necessary precautions.

Level 2, Family Recommended

Travel from one country to the other and see both the Dutch and French influences dating back to 1648. The Dutch arrived first in 1631 looking for wood to make repairs. You'll drive from today's modern Dutch capital of Philipsburg past the Great Salt Pond, which served to make the island 'worth its salt' attracting the French. On the way to the French side, you'll pass the Border Monument which changed 16 times between 1948 and 1816. The tour travels past the picturesque seaside town of Grand Case, known for its architecture and exquisite restaurants before reaching Marigot, the bustling small capital of French St. Martin. After an approximately one hour experiencing the European atmosphere, sidewalk cafes and trendy boutiques, the true meaning of the term 'Best Of' comes through with approximately one hour at one of the island's best beaches.

Level 2, Age Requirements

You will be in 'Hog Heaven' for this ride through both the Dutch and French sides of St. Maarten. After a short bus ride through the capital of Philipsburg, you'll arrive to the staging area where you'll pick up your Harley Davidson motorcycle. Once briefed and issued a helmet, your guide escorts you for a bike ride through the island. The convoy arrives in the French capital of Marigot, home to Fort Louis, built in 1767 to protect the town from the English. The ride continues through the island and the local countryside. This is a unique way to see this fascinating island, shared by two countries

Note: Participants must be at least 18 years of age, at least 25 years of age to drive and are required to provide a valid driver's license with motorcycle endorsement and sign a waiver/release form. Helmet use is mandatory. A major credit card authorization will be required as a deposit for deductible, upon which no charge will be imposed when equipment is returned undamaged. There will be a guide in front and an escort jeep in the back.

SeaWorld Explorer

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 2, Family Recommended

View the stunning sea life and tropical fish of St. Maarten's marine world, in the cool comfort of a cruising, underwater observatory. Departing Philipsburg, your overland transfer takes you through the mountainous middle region to your destination into French Grand Case. Once onboard the semi-submarine 'SeaWorld Explorer', our guide will entertain you en route to Rocher de Creole. Here, a daring diver surrounds himself with clouds of brilliant-colored fish, leading them alongside the viewing chamber for you. Sea turtles, eels, barracudas, and stingrays are just some of the reef residents that you'll spot. Before returning to your ship, relax on the upper deck, quenching your thirst with an island punch while enjoying the scenery across the channel to Anguilla.

Note: Participants must be able to walk 100 feet from bus to boat and negotiate seven steps into hull of boat.

We have gift shops and you can even get a massage, you name it – we have it! We are the beach experts! Double umbrellas are available to rent.

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Board your transportation for the scenic drive to Simpson Bay Lagoon. Upon arrival receive a kayaking lesson and safety orientation before setting off on your sit-on-top kayak. Follow your guide across the largest saltwater lagoon in the Antilles and marvel at this fascinating ecosystem. During your paddle your guide will point out sights of interest, including the imaginary water border between the Dutch and French sides of the island. Keep an eye out for the wildlife that makes its home among the labyrinth of mangroves lining the shore. After a brief rest stop, paddle on to a secluded beach for approximately a one hour swim prior to returning to the kayak terminal. The kayak paddle ends at a beautiful cove where you'll enjoy a complimentary beverage prior to reboarding your

transportation. A brief stop will be made at The Village before the return to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 9 years of age and in good health with no arm, back or neck problems. Maximum weight allowed is 250 lbs. if riding single. Maximum combined weight is 400 lbs. We recommend you wear your bathing suit or comfortable clothing with sandals and bring a towel. This tour is not recommended for guests with any type of back or heart problems or pregnant. Tour includes use of a double kayak.

Scenic Coastal Hike

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Board your transportation for the drive to the scenic lookout point of Guana Bay. Upon arrival a hip-pack containing a bottle of water and a snack bar will be provided, as well as a safety briefing and orientation. From there, follow your knowledgeable guide along the coastal trails through grassy fields and along the rugged eastern coastline. Continue the hike along the trails overlooking the rough Caribbean Sea below to Geneve Bay. Along the way your guide will point out interesting cacti and plant life growing in the area, as well as neighboring islands such as St. Barths, the deserted Isle de Fourche, and Pelican Rock. There will be time for a breather on the rocky beach at Geneve Bay while listening to the relaxing sounds of pebble rocks in the surf. Turning back, follow some other trails until you reach the pristine and sandy Gauna Bay beach.

Note: Participants must be at least 9 years of age and in good health. Maximum weight allowed is 220 lbs. This excursion is recommended for passengers in excellent physical condition. Wear comfortable, sturdy walking shoes and bring adequate sun protection. A bottle of water and complimentary refreshment is provided.

Tiki Hut Snorkel Park

Approximate Duration: 5 hours (Varies)

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

The Tiki Hut is a 110 foot floating platform located behind the cliff of Fort Amsterdam in a calm protected area called Little Bay. Jump in and do some snorkeling – hundreds of fish call our scuttled submarine, small ship wrecks and cannons of Ft. Amsterdam. Turtles, Stingrays, lobster, squid, octopus, and eels visit frequently. There are deck chairs, or if you prefer float in a noodle lounge with a drink in your hand. We have everything you'll need - snorkel gear, lounge chairs, shade, cash bar, bbq, music, and safe storage for your belongings. There are instructors waiting to help you and the four foot deep ocean pool is a great spot to practice.

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age. Bring a towel and cash if you plan on having lunch. Food and drink are available for purchase at the Tiki Hut. Stay as long as you like, the shuttle boat makes trips to downtown and the cruise ship about every 45 minutes.

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 1, Meal

At the pier, you'll board your bus and head to a rustic laidback beach on the French side of the island; nothing fancy, just a local hideout - down to earth and truly Caribbean. Consider this the Oooh-La-La tour of the Caribbean where the worries of everyday life wash away.

Walk along the long stretch of sand, take a dip in the sea, or relax in your beach chair taking in the tropical scenery. As all beaches are public, feel free to roam and enjoy the magnificent sand and warm waters. On your ride back to the pier, you will have the option to be dropped off downtown for shopping or return directly to the ship.

Note: Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. Beaches in St.Maarten are public and swimming is at your own risk; no life guards on duty. Be advised that European-style (clothing optional) and some nudity may be observed throughout beaches in St. Maarten. Please do not leave your personal effects unattended. Umbrellas are not included. Guests wishing to stay downtown for shopping will be responsible for their return transportation to the ship. Beach chair, lunch and a welcome drink are included. There is a French Beach Break also available which does not include lunch or welcome drink. Please book tour PHI__56.

Mount up and follow your guide onto the rocky trail, entering a protected reserve with the natural island habitat of shrubs and bushes, interspersed with various species of cacti. Enjoy the lovely views as you ride, surrounded by the natural flora and fauna and never too far from the ocean. On clear days, you can see the neighboring islands. At Cay Bay, you'll take a short ride along the beach and into the water. Then, ride your horse back to the starting point where the transfer vehicle awaits to drive you to your ship. You will have the option to be dropped off in Philipsburg, making your own way back to the ship.

Cruise the underwater coral gardens off Coki Point in the Nautilus semi-submarine before visiting Coral World, an impressive collection of exhibits and aquariums dedicated to the marine life of the Caribbean. Board an open-air safari bus for the trip to Coral World Ocean Park on Coki Point. Then, step inside Nautilus and walk down a couple of steps to your seat. This is a surface vessel where you sit five feet below the waterline in the air-conditioned comfort of the main cabin. Large viewing ports offer a close-up look at the coral gardens surrounding Coki Point. Watch a diver conduct a fish feeding in front of the viewing ports. After your cruise, enter Coral World Marine Park where you have approximately 90 minutes of free time to explore on your own. Coral World boasts one of the world's largest coral reef tanks and a giant circular aquarium with more than 20 viewing stations. Visit the mangrove lagoon, the turtle pool and the open-air shark tank called Shark Shallows. One of the most popular exhibits is the touch pool, where you can feel starfish, stingrays and even a baby shark. Don't miss the large underwater observatory 100 feet off shore

Note: Participants must be able to navigate stairs and take one large assisted step to board the semi-sub. Guests will be required to walk approximately 1,500 feet from the main entrance of Coral World to the boat dock where the semi-sub ties up. Admire the amber waterfall comprised of over 12,000 stones, the largest in the world, cascading two-stories. Observe a remarkable display of precious amber, hand-crafted into masterpieces of art and jewelry. Colors range from opaque blonde and honey-colored gems of the Baltic to classic examples of Caribbean amber with a suspended insect or leaf in
