## Tour Indicators/Symbols

Level 1:	Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
Level 2:	Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
Level 3:	Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
Guests with Disabilities:	These tours may accommodate guests with limited mobility or in wheelchairs (wheelchair must be collapsible). Please contact the Shore Excursion staff upon boarding to ensure that your needs can be accommodated.
Meal:	Mmmm – these tours include meals. Got a special dietary need? Head to the Shore Excursion Desk and they'll be happy to help you out.
Age Requirements:	These tours have specific age requirements.
Weight Requirements:	These tours have specific weight requirements.
Height Requirements:	These tours have specific height requirements.
C-Card:	These tours mean that you have to present a nationally recognized Scuba certification card and have logged a dive within the past 12 months.

**For those guests wishing to stay in the downtown area to browse or shop after your tour, be advised that there is an easy 10-minute walk back to the tender pier. There is also a dockside flea market next to the tender pier. Tour itinerary might be reversed to avoid congestion at the stops. Participants must be at least 18 years of age to consume alcoholic beverages on any of the following Cabo San Lucas tours. Bring a hat, sunglasses, sunscreen and your camera. Kayaking/snorkeling/diving areas may change due to weather conditions.**

Coastal Highlights

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 1

On this leisurely exploration, you'll see dramatic scenery of desert terrain, breathtaking seascapes and rugged coastline, marked by unusual rock formations. Visit a local glass-blowing factory to observe native craftsmen at work and to purchase glassware. Continue north to the picturesque town of San Jose del Cabo to visit the mission church and its shady tree-lined plaza. Stop at Cacti Mundo, an ecological cactus garden with a collection of over 750 species of cactus. Drive past residential districts and the hotel zone to stop at Sunset Da Giorgio's

Restaurant for a cold beverage and sweeping views of the Cabo San Lucas Bay. Finally, skirt through the small downtown sector where you can stay on your own for some shopping.

Land's End Boat Tour

Approximate Duration: 1 hour

Level 1

Take an approximately 45-minute boat tour along the very tip of the longest, most desolate and perhaps the most beautiful peninsula in the world. Explore pristine beaches, towering rock formations and the famed Los Arcos, a dramatic natural rock monument that arches starkly out of the sea. A complimentary beverage will be served on board while you listen to an enlightening narration by J.M. Cousteau about the underwater life, the colorful history of Baja California and its fragile ecology. You'll soon see that Cabo San Lucas lays claim to miles of unspoiled beaches, little coves and impressive hotels.

Land's End Boat Tour & Scenic Stop

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 1

At the end of the Land's End boat Tour (previously described), you'll be escorted to a waiting vehicle for an approximately 15-minute non-guided drive through town to Sunset Da Giorgio's restaurant. Its spectacular location atop the cliffs at the far end of the bay provides an unforgettable view of Land's End, its famed arches and your ship, at anchor in the bay of Cabo San Lucas. There you'll have ample time to enjoy a complimentary beverage, take pictures or just relax and enjoy the view. Continuous taxi shuttles will whisk you back to the pier for last-minute shopping on your own.

Deluxe Coastal Cruise

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 1

Set course on a delightful two-hour coastal cruise to admire breathtaking landscapes, miles of unspoiled beaches and private secluded coves, while sipping unlimited rum, margaritas, tequila, beer and soda. Enjoy the view of spectacular golf resorts and impressive developments as you cruise along the Sea of Cortez and the Pacific coastline. Cruise by the famed Los Arcos area, where a dramatic natural rock arches starkly out of the sea at the very tip of the longest, most desolate and beautiful peninsula in the world. Cruise by a sea lion colony and the idyllic Lover's Beach – one of the few beaches in the world that share two seas – before heading back into the marina.

Whale Watching & Coastal Cruise

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 1

Between mid-December and March, the waters of the Sea of Cortez are visited by thousands of whales that migrate yearly toward the warmer tides. At least six different types of whales spout and breach as they swim around the gulf. They include California gray whales, finbacks, humpbacks and the mighty blue whales – the largest animals to ever inhabit the earth. Whale watching is a favorite pastime, so keep your cameras poised. The Cousteau Society has done some of its best film making right here. Admire breathtaking landscapes, miles of unspoiled beaches and private secluded coves, while sipping unlimited rum, margaritas, tequila, beer and sodas, and munching on chips and salsa.

**Note:** Only available for the Norwegian Star sailings during whale watching season, from mid-December through March. Sightings are frequent, but not guaranteed.

Discover the Town of Todos Santos

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 2

The Cape region is indeed striking in appearance, from arid desert and white sand coves, to swaying palm trees and deep blue sea. Join your knowledgeable guide on a trip back in time. Your drive will take you north to admire the contrasting coastal scenery. Your destination is Todos Santos – which means 'all saints' – a small oasis village

that sits peacefully next to the Pacific Ocean. Once there, you'll have time to walk around the old Jesuit mission, explore the small shops, glance through one of the many art galleries and visit the famous Hotel California that inspired the Eagles back in 1969. Or just do as the locals do and sit in the town square and watch time go by. A snack and cool refreshment are included. Upon returning to Cabo San Lucas, you may stay in town on your own. Casual, conservative dress is recommended.

Cabo San Lucas Sportfishing

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 2, Meal

Enjoy a five-hour fishing excursion to the richest game fishing grounds know to anglers. As the boat heads out to the fishing area, the poles will be set with lures by the mate to minimize the possibility of the lines becoming tangled. The type of fishing is trolling. Boats do not troll with live bait, as it is good for perhaps 15 minutes maximum. This means the boat will be in the open ocean and four lines with lures will be utilized in pole holders and outriggers. All of the hooked fish will be rotated between the participants on the boat. When a fish is spotted, the mate will reel in the four lines and then set a line with the live bait. If a fish takes the bait, the mate will 'set the hook' and give the pole to the first person in the fighting chair. When the first person has landed the fish (or if the fish got away), the next person will have the next hooked fish and so on. When everyone has had a turn in the chair the rotation will start over.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Due to the nature of this tour, pregnant women or guests with any known medical condition or history of illness, including heart ailment, knee/spinal/neck pain or injury or any other recent injury should not participate. Typically six participants will share a boat, however arrangements can be made, at additional costs to share a boat by two or three anglers, thereby improving your chances of catching a fish. All fishing boats contain the latest in safety equipment.

Level 1, Meal

Whether you want to swim in the pool or feel the sand between your toes, fun in the sun is the order of the day.

Once inside the specially-designed pools, join a small group and meet a bottlenose dolphin who will be yours for this magical experience. This program offers you an approximate 35-minute in water session with the opportunity to pet, play and swim with a dolphin while enjoying an educational program full of fun, excitement and unique activities. Get to know your dolphin as you enjoy a dolphin ride, dance with your dolphin and receive a big fishy kiss. Prepare to smile as professional photographers will be in the water with you to capture life-long memories of your unforgettable adventure. After your swim experience, take advantage of the exclusive lounge bar and restaurant, lined with a refreshing waterfall, shady palms and a delectable food and beverage menu (not included).

**Note:** Participants must be at least 5 years of age. Children 5-10 years old must be accompanied a participating adult. This tour is not for pregnant women or guests with respiratory or heart problems. Family/friends of paying participants may observe free of charge subject to availability. Cabo San Lucas Walking Tour

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 2

Enjoy a leisurely paced walking tour of Cabo San Lucas. Explore a part of Cabo that many never see, such as the famous Cabo Wabo and the incredible buys at the local flea market for starters. After a brief walk from the pier with your tour guide, your first stop is a scenic side street where your warm up for shopping will take place. Then it's off to the church of San Lucas – a small catholic church built in 1730 by Spanish missionaries. Across the street is the main park in town where you'll enjoy a popsicle and walk to the town square to learn about the culturally rich background of Cabo. View a real whale skeleton set up on display. Follow your guide down a scenic side street on your way to the old theatre to enjoy a complimentary, non-alcoholic beverage and after a brief stop there continue past the legendary Cabo Wabo Cantina owned by the 1980s rock star Sammy Hagar of the famed rock band Van Halen. Move on to the local market and try your bargaining skills, from hammocks to clothes, trinkets to leather goods, talavera pottery and much, much more...you'll find all the souvenirs you need at the flea market. You'll have free time to shop before heading back to the pier with your guide.

Dolphin Trainer for a Day

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age Requirements

Become the envy of all as you delve deeper into the world of the bottlenose dolphin at this world-class dolphin center, only a short five-minute walk from the pier. Begin your day by choosing your uniform (yours to keep) and then meet the dolphin trainers. As you form part of this highly experienced team, get to personally know a friendly family of bottlenose dolphins. Prepare their daily diet in the morning and learn about how we care for our dolphins at the on-site laboratory. Enjoy free time in the water with the dolphins as you play with them and assist in the training of these amazing mammals. A full dolphin swim session is included and after a light lunch in the palm-lined deli lounge, become an actual dolphin trainer in the afternoon as you assist with a dolphin swim program. Finish your day receiving your diploma, complimentary photo, DVD of the swim session and the knowledge that you too became a dolphin trainer for a day.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 12 years of age and in good health. Observers are not allowed on this tour. A light lunch from the snack bar is included. Cameras are not allowed on this tour however professional photographs will be taken and are available to view and purchase after the tour. Participants will be asked to sign safety waiver before taking part in the tour.

Surf's Up (Nov-May)

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 3, Age & Weight Requirements

There is truly no other experience that feels the same as catching a great wave. It's a memory that will last with you forever. Don't miss this unique opportunity to learn how to surf. A pleasant drive will take you to a surf break with your local experienced guide. Upon arrival to the beach, you'll be assigned your gear, which includes a state of the art foam long board and rash guard or wet suit. You'll be instructed on the right technique that will make your water time more fun and easy. Then hit the water and prepare to hang ten with the locals. Your instructor will help you catch waves and give you tips while you are in the water. There is one instructor for every 4 to 5 guests. There will also be free time for you to relax on the beach or hit the waves again after your lesson.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 12 years of age, weigh no more than 220 lbs. and in good physical condition. Not recommended for guests with hip, back, neck problems or pregnant women. Signed liability waiver required before participation. There are two surf breaks that are used depending on the time of year. One is about 15 to 20 minutes closer than the other. Only available for the Norwegian Star sailings from November through May.

Sea Kayak & Snorkel Adventure

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

This is a short and pleasant paddling experience to the magnificent Los Arcos, a dramatic natural rock that arches starkly out of the sea at Land's End. You'll be transported by water taxi from the pier to the kayak launching area and geared up as your guide briefs you. Easy paddling of your two-person kayak will take you across the San Lucas Bay, an underwater park and marine sanctuary and to the famed Lover's Beach, only accessible by water and one of the few beaches in the world that joins two seas: the Sea of Cortez and the Pacific Ocean. paddle back to the beach, you'll return to the tender pier by water taxi.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 12 years of age and weigh no more than 220 lbs. This tour is not for pregnant women or guests with knee, back, neck or heart problems. Guests must be physically fit and able to paddle a kayak 1-1/2 miles. Snorkeling gear and a bottle of water will be provided. Snorkeling instructions are available upon request. Wear your swimsuit and bring towel.

Pacific Beach Horseback Ride

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

A 30-minute drive through the desert takes you to a seaside ranch where your horse will be waiting. After brief instructions, you and your horse will begin a leisurely one-hour beach ride along the powerful waters of the Pacific Ocean. Your beach ride will take you atop a sand dune, from where during the months of January through March, you'll be able to spot the migrant whales swimming very close by. After your ride, enjoy a complimentary beverage at the ranch where you'll have a short time to explore the traditional desert houses, interact with the farm animals and check out the boutique filled with local arts and crafts before returning to the pier.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 12 years of age, weigh no more than 240 lbs. and be in good physical condition. Not for pregnant women or guests with knee, back, neck, or heart problems. Long pants, closed-toe shoes and a hat are strongly suggested. Signature on liability waiver required before participation; this tour is suitable for riders of all experience levels, including first-timers. Horses do not enter the water.

Up-Close Whale Watching by Zodiac

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 3, Age & Weight Requirements

Be one of the lucky few to enjoy an intimate and action-packed whale watching excursion! Board a 24-foot Zodiac boat powered by twin 115HP engines with a maximum capacity of 15 passengers. This vessel is zippy and maneuverable but at the same time very safe and seaworthy. Your experienced Captain also serves as your tour guide. He will give you an informational and educational tour. Board your boat right at the tender pier and head out in search of the migrating whales visiting the waters off Cabo. The Sea of Cortez and the Pacific Ocean host numerous whale species each season including humpbacks, grays, as well as the more elusive blues whales and occasional pods of dolphin and orcas. This excursion is called 'Up-Close' for a reason. Once a whale is spotted, your boat will get you there quickly and quietly without disturbing the whales. Keep those cameras handy, you'll want to record your experience of a lifetime before you head back to the pier. There will be time for you to do some sightseeing as your boat cruises by Land's End for a good view of the Arch, the sea lion colony and Lover's Beach.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 7 years of age and weigh no more than 250 lbs. You must wear your life jacket at all times. Pregnant women and guests with back/neck injuries are not permitted on this tour. Bottled water and soft drinks are provided. Comfortable clothing and sun protection is suggested. Shoes must be removed and stored in a storage locker on board your boat to keep your gear out of the way. This is a seasonal tour running from December 15 through March 31, only available for the Norwegian Star. Sightings are frequent, but not guaranteed. Please note that ride can be bumpy. This tour is available from the months of December through March.

Cabo San Lucas Parasailing

Approximate Duration: 1 ½ hours

Level 3, Age & Weight Requirements

Your boat will pull up right at the pier where you and five other participants will board, don your life jackets and get ready for the thrill of your life. As the boat motors out through the Cabo harbor and into the bay, you'll be fitted with a harness and then one at a time, you'll sit down on the back of the boat, it's simple and easy... the boat does the rest! You'll soar up to 600 feet depending on the wind and water conditions. Tandem is possible depending on the combined weight of the participants and wind speed at the moment. Take your camera up with you and create aerial memories to show your friends and prove that you really did it! Get a bird's eye view of Land's End. You stay dry – take off and landing is from the back of the boat. You're not dipped in the water. Actual flight time is approximately 10 minutes each.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 7 years of age and those under 18 must be accompanied by an adult (adult need not fly, but must buy a ride-along ticket). Required minimum weight should be at least 100 lbs. with a

maximum combined weight of 450 lbs. depending on wind and weather conditions. This tour is not for pregnant women and those guests with neck or back problems, as boat ride can be rough at times. Bottled water and soft drinks are included. Life jackets must be worn at all times. Comfortable clothing and sun protection suggested.

4x4 Rhino Kart Experience

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 3, Age & Weight Requirements

There is no better way to explore Baja's desert and ocean beauty than from aboard your safe and fun Yamaha Rhino®. Along your ride, you'll see cacti over 20 feet high, towering over the trail. Stops will be made along the way to inform you about the desert flora and fauna as well as at a lookout point over the Pacific Ocean. Take your camera as you'll have many photo opportunities on this excursion. Your drive will take you to a seaside ranch along the mighty Pacific Ocean where you'll receive instructions and equipment. Hop on your assigned vehicle and follow your guide for a glimpse into Baja's rugged terrain. Your 4x4 Rhino® will take you effortlessly over hilltops and through river washes. Upon returning to the ranch you'll have a few minutes to explore the traditional desert adobe houses before returning to the pier.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 12 years of age. Drivers must be at least 25 years of age to operate vehicle. Maximum weight per person is 275 lbs. Due to the nature of this tour, pregnant women or guests with a heart condition, knee pain or injury, spinal and/or neck problems should not participate. Wear long pants, closed-toe shoes and bring sunscreen. Signature on liability waiver is required.

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Come with us to explore both of Baja's beauties, the desert and ocean. You'll be assigned to a Baja Buggy which will take you into Baja's rugged desert to experience first-hand how the local residents still live to this day. Driving along quaint local back roads you'll definitely be off the beaten path. Keep your eyes open as the wildlife along the trails will make for some great photos. Along the way, you'll see a few local working ranches complete with its herds of cows, chickens and goats. Your drive will continue along one of the area's largest river washes taking you to either Chileno Bay or Santa Maria Cove for some beach time and swimming fun. You'll have ample time to explore the palm-lined beach in search of buried pirate treasures or splash into the refreshing waters of the Sea of Cortez. Fresh fruit and drinks will be served. Your return drive will take you along the coast, past some of the area's most exclusive hotels and golf courses.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 6 years of age; drivers must be at least 25 years of age and weigh no more than 250 lbs. Not recommended for guests with hip, back, neck problems or pregnant women. This is not a snorkeling tour. There are 4 passengers per vehicle and driving responsibilities will be shared by those who meet the age requirements above. Signed waiver is required before participation.

The return across downtown to the tender pier will be on the same vehicles departing from the drop-off point.

**Note:** You may wish to walk back across town to the pier, an approximately 30-minute walk.
