Tour Indicators/Symbols

Level 1:	Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
Level 2:	Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
Level 3:	Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.

Hilo, Hawaii

Volcanoes National Park

Approximate Duration: 4 ¾ hours

Level 1, Guests with Disabilities

Explore Volcanoes National Park and learn about Hawaii's Goddess of Fire, Madame Pele, as you drive along the crater's rim as allowed by park rangers; due to activity, parts may be closed. Standing at just over 4,000 feet, Kilauea is not the tallest volcano on the Big Island, but it's certainly the most active. Pass the Halemaumau Fire Pit and the Kilauea Iki Crater before stopping at the Thurston Lava Tube, where a short walk gives you the opportunity for an up-close view of an extinct lava tube. This tour also visits the Hawaii Volcano Observatory and Jaggar Museum. Finally, end your day with a visit to Big Island Candies where you can sample the tasty treats and take some home.

Note: While at Volcanoes National Park, you won't see molten lava. Thurston Lava Tube is not wheelchair accessible due to uneven pathways and steps. An additional optional shopping stop may be provided.

Volcano & Rainbow Falls Deluxe with Lunch

Approximate Duration: 5 ½ hours

Level 1, Guests with Disabilities, Meal

Your tour begins with a scenic short drive to Wailuku River State Park and Rainbow Falls. The 80-foot falls cascade into a circular pool at the base of the Wailuku River. Your adventure continues to the spectacular Nani Mau Botanical Gardens. Then, take an approximately 60-minute drive to Volcanoes National Park, where 70 million years of volcanic history are on display. Here, you can admire the remarkable view of Kilauea Volcano, the earth's most active volcano. Then, drive along the 11-mile-long crater's rim as allowed by park rangers, (due to activity, parts may be closed), and enjoy a unique view of this volcanic landscape and learn about Madame Pele, Hawaii's Goddess of Fire. Trace the birth of the Hawaiian Islands when you visit the Hawaii Volcano Observatory and the Jaggar Museum. You'll also have the opportunity to walk through the Thurston Lava Tube before a visit to Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Factory.

Note: While at Volcanoes National Park, you won't see molten lava. Thurston Lava Tube is not wheelchair accessible due to uneven pathways and steps. An additional optional shopping stop may be provided. A boxed lunch will be provided for you to enjoy throughout the excursion.

Mauna Kea

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 1, Meal, Age Requirements

Mauna Kea Volcano, the tallest mountain in the world, measures 32,000 feet from its base to its summit at 13,796 feet above sea level. This dormant volcano is also the most sought-after astronomical site, with 13 telescopes representing 12 countries. Mauna Kea houses the most powerful observatories and telescopes, including the Keck Twin Telescopes which have the world's largest mirrors. Your 'sea to sky' experience will start as you make your way through the historic town of Hilo northwest toward Mauna Kea. The view atop Mauna Kea can only be described as 'majestic,' with the clouds often far below you. This tour also includes a stop at the Onizuka Visitor Center.

Note: Participants must be at least 16 years of age. Oxygen is carried for emergencies. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women, persons suffering from respiratory disorders or heart problems. Warm parkas are provided, as the temperatures at the summit may be cold. In rare cases where the summit is closed due to sudden storms, an alternate will be provided. A light lunch is included.

Hilo Coast & Botanical Gardens

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 2

Located on Onomea Bay, this world-renowned tropical garden is a nature preserve that is acclaimed by visitors as 'the most beautiful area in Hawaii.' En route, your narrated tour takes you through the Japanese-style Liliuokalani Gardens, along Hilo Bay and the lush Hamakua Coast to Onomea Bay. Here, in the Hawaii Tropical Botanical Gardens, more than 2,500 species of tropical plant life have been assembled from regions all over the world; and the plants are labeled for easy identification. You'll receive a map of the garden's trails at the Visitor Center, and then enjoy your time wandering the garden grounds on your own, taking photographs or simply enjoying the incredible beauty.

Hawaiian Eco-safari

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 1, Meal

Enjoy a day of exploration into the formation, population, history, and culture of the Hawaiian Islands. Visit the Panaewa Rainforest Zoo, the only rainforest zoo in America, where you'll see a collection of rare Hawaiian birds and many other interesting exhibits. Namaste, the white tiger is always a crowd favorite. Then, you'll visit the Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Farm's Visitors Center, and learn about the native plants. At Lava Tree Park, take a short walk to view the 'lava trees' which are a lasting example of what happens when a lava flow overruns a rainforest. On the way to Ahalanui Park, view the Kapoho Lava Flow which destroyed the village of Kapoho in 1960. Finally, enjoy a relaxing dip in the geo-thermal pool, which is fed by fresh water that is heated by the volcano, making temperatures as high as 95 degrees. Or, just take in the breathtaking ocean views.

Circle of Fire

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 1, Flight

See Earth's most geologically active environment, the Kilauea Volcano, on a thrilling helicopter ride. This remarkable 45-minute flightseeing tour emphasizes the current areas of volcanic activity. Fly over Kilauea's most recent eruption sites and follow the surface activity down to the devastated village of Kalapana. View lava flows, the Puna Forest and black-sand beaches, which were formed by lava that was cooled by water. In the course of your tour, you'll receive an informative commentary from your tour guide/pilot over an individual headset.

Note: Guests 250 lbs. and over are charged an additional rate to reserve two seats for safety and comfort. These spaces are capacity controlled. While booking on line, if you do not see the option for 250 lbs. and over, this means that these spaces are sold out. Please do not book the under 250 lbs. selection, but check with the Shore Excursion Desk once on board the ship to see if more seats or another departure time has become available. This tour is non-refundable once booked.

Kilauea Volcano Hike

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 3, Meal, Age Requirements

Head to Kilauea Volcano with a certified hiking guide. This is a rare opportunity to experience the most educational and inspirational hike at the world's most active volcano. If you really want to learn about the details and depths of Hawaii's volcanic processes, then this is the hike for you! Your specially trained naturalist guide will provide engaging details about Kilauea's volcanic activity, plants, animals, history, and cultural significance. Your hike will immerse you in the fantastic terrain, microclimates, and flora of Kilauea as you pass over lava fields, rainforest, near steam vents, and through a lava tube (literally inside the volcano!). Come out for an unforgettably exciting and educational day.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and wear sturdy closed-toe shoes. A light lunch is included.

Crater Hike & Akaka Falls

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 3, Meal, Age Requirements

From dramatic black lava flows to lush native rainforests and magnificent waterfalls, you'll experience the best Hilo has to offer. Take in the beauty of Hawaiian nature as you pass wild orchids, ferns and Kahili ginger plants. Once in the Volcanoes National Park, visit a lava tube, discover remarkable volcanic formations and hike out to a volcanic crater. The three-mile roundtrip hike crosses pahoehoe lava, meanders through forests of lava trees, and passes gaping, steaming fissures where lava once fountained hundreds of feet skyward. After the park, you'll head north passing charming, historic Hilo and drive along the scenic Hamakua coast to one of Hawaii's most impressive waterfalls. You'll stop at Akaka Falls State Park, where the 442-foot Akaka Falls drops over lushly green coated cliffs into a deep pool below. The jungle creates a magical backdrop on a journey full of beauty and adventure. From the beauty of the rainforests flora and fauna to the beast of the devastation at Volcanoes National Park, this is a part of Hawaii you'll always remember.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and reasonably fit. Infants are not permitted, even if carried by adults. Wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes. Due to natural sulfur gases, this tour is not recommended for those with respiratory or heart problems. A light lunch is included.

Hilo Bay Waterfall & Kayak

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Your adventure begins at a black-sand beach in the heart of Hilo, just a short distance from the cruise ship pier. Enjoy a great time on the water with fun guides and amazing views and look out for a glimpse of the Mauna Kea Summit. Hilo is America's wettest city, so be prepared for plenty of rainbows and a lush tropical coastline. Your kayaking excursion will take you out past Coconut Island and along Hilo's shoreline with magnificent views of the Wailoa Park Estuary and the Wailuku River Waterfall, where the 18-mile river reaches the ocean.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and weigh no more than 250 lbs. This tour is not recommended for those with back problems or heart conditions. Wear a swimsuit and bring a towel. Tour is weather dependent.

Kilauea Volcano Biking

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Age & Height Requirements

Your exciting day begins with a scenic narrated drive from the cruise ship pier to the Visitor's Center at the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park by way of the famous Banyan Drive and Liliuokalani Gardens in Hilo. Fill your senses with the ride of a lifetime! Experience the volcano up-close and personal as you ride through lush rainforest and lava frozen in time on your 21-speed mountain bike. Your cycling adventure is an eight-mile ride on paved roads around the crater rim. It consists of mostly level terrain with a couple of small uphill sections. Along with the cycling portion, you'll hike through an incredible rainforest that leads you directly through an amazing lava tube. Other mini hikes are to scenic overlooks to witness the heart of the volcano exploding at Halemaumau Crater. Enjoy island fresh fruit, macadamia nuts and other assorted snacks during the tour. This fully narrated adventure is truly one of a kind! After your ride, stop at the Jaggar Museum where you'll see videos of the volcano erupting. The Jaggar Museum is also home to many seismographs, which monitor every twitch of the Earth. Your day will include a stop at the famous Big Island Candies known for its famous handmade Hawaiian treats. Throughout the tour your guide will share with you history and geology of the area during the frequent stops along the way – an exciting and active way to spend the day at the volcano.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, a minimum of 4' 6" in height and know how to ride a bicycle. Bike, helmet, gloves and rain jacket are provided. Natural sulfur gases may affect those with respiratory problems. You won't see molten lava on this tour. Tour itinerary may change due to severe weather or volcanic activity.

Ultimate Helicopter & Waterfall Adventure

Approximate Duration: 5 ½ hours

Level 2, Flight, Meal, Ultimate Touring

Imagine soaring over Kilauea Volcano on a thrilling helicopter tour, a dramatic remote landing for a refreshing swim under a waterfall, and a return drive that visits scenic waterfalls and tropical rainforests. You'll start by boarding your comfortable, air-conditioned aircraft and head out towards the active volcano. Lush tropical rainforests give way to stark black lava that flows as you approach the volcano. Look for surface flows and lava entering the ocean as your pilot safely navigates the helicopter over the volcanic landscape. Then, you'll circle back and head north past Hilo. Fly over prime rainforests, laced with waterfalls to your remote landing spot. Cleared by ground crew, your pilot will then land the helicopter at the breathtaking location where you'll be met by your guide. Here you can enjoy a refreshing swim in a natural mountain pool fed by a 40-foot waterfall, explore the old flume system that carried water to crops in the sugarcane days, or just relax in a private pavilion. Enjoy a Hawaiian BBQ lunch prepared by your guides. Finally, on your return enjoy a scenic drive through Onomea Bay and stops at Akaka Falls and Rainbow Falls.

Note: Guests 250 lbs. and over are charged an additional rate to reserve two seats for safety and comfort. These spaces are capacity controlled. While booking on line, if you do not see the option for 250 lbs. and over, this means that these spaces are sold out. Please do not book the under 250 lbs. selection, but check with the Shore Excursion Desk once on board the ship to see if more seats or another departure time has become available. This tour is non-refundable once booked. Tour may run in reverse. Flight time is approximately 60 minutes.

The Land of Frozen Fire

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2

From the pier you'll head to the 'wild west' town of Pahoa with its boardwalks, and Lava Tree State Park with its towering trees, on the eastern rift zone of Kilauea Volcano. Visit Ahalanui's warm springs, with its volcanically heated water. Along the way and during brief stops, view the dramatic and beautiful scenery formed when lava meets the sea: cliffs, lava tubes and blow holes. At Kaimu, once the site of a famous black-sand beach and a small town, both destroyed by a 1990 lava flow, a stop is made where you can walk on the 'frozen fire' and view the active volcanic vent in the distance. Visit a survivor of the eruption, Uncle Robert's Hawaiian Village with a nearby snack shop where you can make purchases. View a picture exhibit of the area you just walked on and see how it looked prior to the 1990 lava flow.

Note: Participants must wear closed-toe shoes and be able to walk short distances unaided.

Big Island – Zipline through Paradise

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Take your need for speed to new heights on this thrilling zipline adventure. Covering nearly two miles of gorgeous tropical river gorges, our 9 line zip course and giant swing is fun for the whole family. View 14 waterfalls including the famous triple-tiered Umauma Falls as you safely soar 160 feet above them. Our certified staff will guide you over the longest zipline on Hawaii's Big Island at more than 2,100 feet in length, which is also the longest and tallest side-by-side dual-track zipline on the Big Island! The tour includes a fully narrated drive through Hilo and the famous Hamakua coast, light snacks and water.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and weigh between 80 and 260 lbs. If you are pregnant or have had past heart, neck or back problems, this tour is not for you.

Secrets of Puna

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal, Family Recommended

Cool off under swaying palm trees in a natural lava rock lagoon and feel the warmth of a black-sand beach between your toes. Drive across the black lava flows, in a private SUV or van to the Puna District and Kilauea Volcano. Hear first-hand stories of life in Kalapana from the former residents who witnessed the destruction. You'll walk across the lava flows which entomb the former village of Kalapana, and find the new black-sand beach of Kaimu. Enjoy a Hawaiian BBQ lunch at a private working macadamia nut and honey farm prepared by your guide. Learn what it's like to operate a macadamia nut farm sitting on the most active volcano in the world. After lunch, travel across the stark black lava flows to find where the lava met the sea in the 1960 eruption. Your next destination is Lava Tree State Park for a short walk, where in 1790 a lava flow covered the jungle and Ohia trees. Finally your guide will share a beautiful coastal lagoon, protected by a reef, and home to tropical fish and the occasional giant green sea turtle. Swim, snorkel, or explore the fascinating coastline here before you return to your ship.

Note: Tour capacity is limited, molten lava will not be seen and order of itinerary may vary. Lunch includes cold local beer, French champagne, juice, sodas and water.

Volcano, Black Sand Beach & Jungle Walk

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

Explore an active volcano from the inside out! Start in the lava-buried village of Kalapana where a short walk across the recent lava flow reveals the beautiful black-sand beach at Kaimu. Look for surface outbreaks and ocean entries of the current eruption. We then make our way down the Puna coast to Mackenzie State Park for an amazing view of the 40-foot cliffs that meet the Pacific Ocean. Next travel across the stark black lava flows to find where the lava met the sea in the 1960 eruption. We then travel to an iron-based cinder cone for a photo opportunity. This cinder cone was another creation of the Kilauea eruption of 1960. Finally we explore Lava Tree State Park where we'll take a short walk to a 1790 lava flow which covered the jungle and ohia trees. This is certainly the perfect way to end your Big Island volcano adventure!

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. If you have any back problems, existing heart conditions or are pregnant, this tour is not for you. You must wear sturdy closed-toe shoes. You won't see molten lava on this tour. Order of itinerary may change.

Cave, Lagoon & Waterfall Trek

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

This adventure takes you off the beaten path to explore remote treasures often unseen by the average traveler. Hike through the 'back door' of Rainbow Falls by way of gigantic banyan and mango trees. Venture down into an area known as 'boiling pots' where water from the Wailuku River rushes through old lava rocks and lava tubes creating a 'boiling' effect. Climb down an almost vertical staircase to explore Kaumanu Caves. Then, leaving the depths of the Earth, continue on to the rugged coastline of King's Landing. Throughout the day, your local Hawaiian guides will fill your senses with stories from long ago and show you sights that you have only dreamed about. It'll be a day to remember and you'll feel rich indeed by having experienced Hilo's hidden treasures.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age.

Approximate Duration: 6 ½ hours

Level 1, Meal, Age Requirements

Start your morning right with locally-grown and freshly roasted Hawaiian coffee at the famous Hilo Coffee Mill on your way to the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park. Once you arrive at the park, an experienced guide will take your intimate sized group on short leisurely hikes through lush rainforest alive with native birds, incredible foliage and a 'walk through' lava tube. Explore hidden overlooks off the beaten path and witness the explosive power of Halemaumau Crater. Walk across new lava formations and actually see the rebirth of the native Hawaiian rainforest in its first stages of life. Enjoy a stop at the Jaggar Museum with its real time seismographs, eruption footage and beautiful displays of lava and Hawaiian geology. After a picnic-style gourmet lunch, journey to the Volcano Winery for an unforgettable wine tasting that includes award-winning selections and uniquely crafted wines made with exotic fruits from around the island. No gourmet adventure would be complete without a stop at Big Island Candies known for their handmade macadamia nut shortbread cookies dipped in chocolate!

Note: To enjoy this adventure, participants must be at least 8 years of age. Participants must be at least 21 years of age to sample the wine. Natural sulfur gases may affect those with respiratory problems. Tour itinerary may change due to weather or volcanic activity.

Honolulu, Oahu

Pearl Harbor & Honolulu City

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 1, Guests with Disabilities, Debar

After departing the pier, drive directly to Pearl Harbor and the Arizona Memorial Visitor Center. Following a short orientation, a motor launch will take you to the memorial, which straddles the hull of the USS Arizona. This is the final resting place for many of the crewmen killed on December 7, 1941. Enjoy a stop at the statue of the great ruler, King Kamehameha. See Iolani Palace, the residence of Hawaii's monarchy, and Kawaiahao, Hawaii's oldest church, as well as Washington Place, once home to Queen Liliuokalani. Your tour concludes with a drive through the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific, Punchbowl, in the crater of an extinct volcano. Then, relax and enjoy the panoramic city views on your drive to the airport.

Note: This tour is only available for guests with flights after 4:00 pm. Guests are responsible for ensuring their debarkation tours are compatible with their flight departure times. This tour does not necessarily drop off at all NCL program hotels, please check with the shore excursions staff onboard as to which hotel drop-offs are available. Guests have the option to book their flights through our Premium Air Department to ensure that flight departure times do not interfere with debark tours. Pearl Harbor & USS Missouri

Approximate Duration: 7 ½ hours

Level 1, Debar

Celebrate the honor, valor and courage of the World War II US servicemen on this special tour. This nostalgic journey takes you to the two places that marked the beginning and the end of the war for the United States – Pearl Harbor and the USS Missouri. At the site of Pearl Harbor, visit the Arizona Memorial where the remains of the USS Arizona lie silent beneath the waves. The 1941 attack on Pearl Harbor will unfold in detailed narrations and photos. From here you'll travel across the Ford Island Bridge to the historic USS Missouri battleship, nicknamed the 'Mighty Mo.' Explore the passages, rooms and corridors on a self-guided tour.

Note: This tour is only available for guests with flights after 6:00 pm. Guests are responsible for ensuring their debarkation tours are compatible with their flight departure times. This tour does not necessarily drop off at all NCL program hotels, please check with the shore excursions staff onboard as to which hotel drop-offs are available. Guests have the option to book their flights through our Premium Air Department to ensure that flight departure times do not interfere with debark tours. Due to heightened security, absolutely no purses, backpacks, fanny packs or camera cases are allowed at Pearl Harbor. Cameras are permitted, but not camera cases. Snacks will be available for purchase. Tour will not be available for August 29th through November 28th, 2009 sailings.
