Coral World

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

From the three-story Observatory Tower built right into the ocean, descend below the sea to view the diverse marine life. The mid-level of the tower houses a 50,000-gallon predator tank, home to sharks, barracuda and moray eels. The park has several large outdoor pools where you can get close to baby sharks, stingrays, turtles, and a pool where you can touch a variety of invertebrates. You'll also have an opportunity to visit the Marine Gardens, where its 21 aquariums will provide you with an up-close view of the unusual behaviors and organisms of the Caribbean reef. After a while in the park, feel free to follow the boardwalk to Coki Beach, to snorkel and view the tame fish in shallow water or just soak up some sun!

Note: Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Champagne Catamaran Sail & Snorkel

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Family Recommended

Glide along the eastern end of St. Thomas before setting sail to beautiful St. John. The invigorating sail across Pillsbury Sound brings the catamaran to its special mooring destination at beautiful St. John's beach, where you can swim, snorkel, or simply relax. Enjoy freshly baked breads, cheeses, fruits and a variety of beverages back onboard the catamaran. Champagne and other beverages are complimentary after swimming and snorkeling.

Note: Wear your bathing suit and bring a towel. Guests must be able to navigate a 6-step ladder through a hatchway on a moving vessel to access space-restricted restroom facilities. Guests entering the water must be able to reboard the vessel without assistance.

Atlantis Submarine

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 1, Height Requirements, Family Recommended

This submarine expedition begins with an approximately 20-minute scenic ferry ride to the submarine dive site where you'll board Atlantis 15, Atlantis' newest, high-tech submarine. The dive begins just outside Turtle Cove, down to a shallow soft coral garden. The sub goes down to a region where large brain coral, stag horn and pillar coral surround the exterior of the submarine. As you travel deeper, to a depth of up to 90-feet, the sub begins its journey through a canyon area called Snapper Valley. Marvel at the abundant varieties of sea life and perhaps catch a glimpse of a shark! After the 40- to 50-minute, one-and-a-half-mile submerged course is completed, the sub will ascend back to the surface where you'll board your transfer back to the ship.

Note: Participants must be 3 feet tall and be able to climb a seven-step ladder.

Screamin' Eagle Jet Boat

Approximate Duration: 1 hour

Level 2, Age & Height Requirements

This awesome 700 HP turbo-charged jet boat will take you on an incredible high-speed harbor and coastline tour for 40 minutes of fun and excitement! You'll experience a mixture of fun, beautiful scenery, crystal-clear waters, warm sea spray and exhilarating speed along with breathtaking 180-degree spins. The Screamin' Eagle is the sightseeing thrill-ride of a lifetime.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and at least 4 feet tall.

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Guests with Disabilities

Travel along picturesque Skyline Drive, with views of St. John, the nearby British Virgin Islands and the magnificent harbor of Charlotte Amalie nestled below. Stop at Mountain Top, the highest point on the island and home of the 'World-Famous Banana Daiquiri' with panoramic views of Megan's Bay – rated by National Geographic Magazine as one of the top 10 beaches in the world. Take some time to browse through Mountain Top's charming Caribbean-themed mall, before continuing to St. Peter Great House and Botanical Gardens. This is a magnificent Caribbean estate, featuring stunning views, classic Caribbean architecture, and vintage furnishings in a beautiful, tropical setting. Stroll the lush grounds, perched 1,000 feet above the ocean that is home to parrots, lovebirds, lorikeets, and more than 100 varieties of tropical fauna. This is a 'must see' in the Caribbean, affording stunning photo opportunities. Continue on to the bustling capital of Charlotte Amalie, where you may choose to return to your ship or remain in town to enjoy the world-class duty-free shopping. You are then responsible for the return to your ship.

Note: Guests ending the tour in Charlotte Amalie are responsible for their taxi fare back to the ship. Tours departing in the afternoon do not have the option of remaining in Charlotte Amalie for shopping. There are steps at St. Peter Great House. The Botanical Nature trail is 2 flights of stairs down and 2 flights of stairs back up. Mountain Top has flat entry and easy access for those who are mobility impaired.

St. John Beach Escape

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Escape to the most pristine of the U.S. Virgin Islands – beautiful St. John. At Charlotte Amalie (or Havensight), you'll board a ferry for a short cruise through Pillsbury Sound to the island of St. John. Upon arrival, you'll board an open-air safari taxi for a relaxing ride to Trunk Bay, considered one of the most beautiful beaches in the world. Along the way, you'll have the opportunity to view and photograph spectacular sights alongside the Caribbean Sea. Stops include the Cruz Bay overlook, Caneel Bay and Hawksnest Bay. Enjoy one-and-a-half hours at beautiful Trunk Bay to swim, snorkel, sunbathe, or just relax under swaying palm trees. Afterward, you'll reboard your transport and take a short trip back to Cruz Bay, where you can do a little shopping as you wait for the scenic return ferry cruise to St. Thomas.

St. John Eco Hike

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Enjoy a trip to St. John and visit some of its National Park trails. Fabulous flora and fauna surround you on this approximately two-mile hike through the lush natural forest. Hike up to Lind Point and enjoy views of St. Thomas and the British Virgin Islands. You will be given an informative history of St. John and listen to the tales of Bluebeard, Sir Francis Drake and the legendary pirate days. Descend to beautiful Honeymoon Beach to relax and enjoy a refreshing dip in the turquoise waters before continuing on a short botanical walk to the ruins of Caneel Bay Plantation.

Note: Participants must be at least 7 years of age, weigh no more than 275 lbs., be in good physical condition and must be able to walk over uneven terrain in tropical climate. Ferry is an approximately 45-minute ride each way. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Sea Trekkin' Helmet Dive

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Get down – way down under the Caribbean Sea wearing a high-tech helmet that allows you to breathe and walk under water. Explore coral reefs and vibrant marine life 10-20-feet down and meet sharks, eels, seahorses and more. The helmet keeps your head completely dry and you can even wear your glasses or contact lenses. After a tour briefing, you'll be outfitted with water shoes and gloves and then descend a ladder into 10 feet of deep blue sea on a guided trail around coral beds and marine life. A storage box is available for your belongings while on your dive. The trail has a handrail for its entirety to add stability. The tour takes approximately 30-minutes. Afterwards, you'll have time to meet the lorikeets, sea lions, sharks, eels, seahorses, puffer fish and much more on display at Coral World Ocean Park.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, weigh between 80 and 350 lbs., able to walk and climb a ladder, in good physical condition and sign a waiver. This tour is not recommended for guests with physical disabilities or claustrophobia. Activities may be reversed to avoid congestion at the dive site.

Downtown Shopping & Megan's Bay Beach

Approximate Duration: 6 1/2 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Join us for two hours of shopping in beautiful downtown Charlotte Amalie. After shopping for gifts and treasures, head back to your cruise ship where you'll have 30 minutes to unload your possessions and hurry back to reboard your open air safari bus for a scenic ride to Megan's Bay Beach where you'll enjoy two hours to experience the crystal clear waters, white sand beaches, and spectacular palm fringed coastline. Enjoy plenty of swimming, sunbathing, beachcombing, and just plain old relaxing before your return drive to the ship.

Note: Wear your swimsuit, bring a towel and sunscreen. A credit card may be required for rentals and food concession. Restroom facilities are available both downtown and at the beach.

Meet your driver at the pier and enjoy an exhilarating ride along Skyline Drive, one of the most scenic routes on this beautiful island. Of course, you'll stop along the way for some breathtaking photo opportunities! Enjoy picturesque down-island views from Beacon Point before visiting Mountain Top, home of the Banana Daiquiri, where you'll have time to browse the charming Caribbean-themed bazaar and take in views of the surrounding British Virgin Islands. At Drake's Seat – Sir Francis' vantage point in the heyday of local pirates – gaze below to the crystalline waters at heart-shaped Megan's Bay Beach, named one of the top 10 beaches in the world by National Geographic. Relax on the ride down to the capital of Charlotte Amalie, a duty-free shopping paradise, where bargains await you on jewelry, electronics, liquor and other souvenirs! Guests will enjoy two hours of world-renowned shopping, before meeting up with your driver at a designated location for your return to the ship.

Note: Participants must be capable of walking distances of up to 500 ft to board their tour vehicle. A camera and comfortable walking shoes are recommended.

Mini Boat Adventure

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Have an adventure of a lifetime being a Captain or the first mate of your own private vessel while visiting a beautiful destination with excellent snorkeling in the emerald clear waters of famous Christmas Cove. This exciting escape begins with a safari ride to a marina where experienced guides will greet you and provide an orientation for your forthcoming adventure. You'll then board your 'Mini Boat' and head out into the open water in a 25hp motor and 12-foot rigid inflatable boat for a scenic ride along the southern coastline until you arrive at the gorgeous destination of Christmas Cove. Here you can bask in the sun, swim or snorkel in the water as you observe the beautiful coral and tropical fish that inhabit this area. At the end of your boating adventure you'll wind down at the marina with rum punch or soft drinks while awaiting your safari bus to take you back to your cruise ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Minimum weight allowed is 80 lbs. Maximum weight allowed is 250 lbs. Wear your bathing suit and bring a towel. Ride may be zippy and bumpy. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women and those with back/neck injuries and recent surgery. Calm waters at snorkeling destination.

Soak up the views on the scenic Skyride to Paradise Point. The Skyride takes you approximately 700 feet above sea level to one of the most amazing views in the Caribbean! Enjoy a panoramic vista of the harbor, cruise ships and the hillside town of Charlotte Amalie. The round-trip Skyride ride is 15 minutes, allowing plenty of time at the top to relax with a frozen drink or lunch. The Skyride is located directly across the street from the Havensight Mall. Come at your leisure, as the Skyride runs continuously.

Kayak, Hike & Snorkel of Cas Cay

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Experience the St. Thomas Mangrove Wildlife Refuge & Marine Sanctuary. The nature guides will explain the ecosystem during a rest stop while kayaking to the deserted island. After finding a hermit crab village, discover breathtaking volcanic cliffs and the impressive Red Point Blow Hole. Then, snorkel in the clear, protected waters of the coral-fringed mangrove nursery and over the remnants of a shipwreck. Look for iguanas, pelicans, rays, octopus, barracuda, and colorful reef fish. Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age, weigh no more than 275 lbs. and must be able to get in and out of kayaks unassisted. Snorkel equipment, a snack and beverage is included. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

St. John Island Tour

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Upon arriving in St. John, you'll view some of the most wonderful sights in the Caribbean, including white-sand beaches, crystal-clear waters and island views of the British Virgin Islands. You'll also see Cinnamon Bay, one of the last working plantations on St. John. Back along the north shore coast road you'll stop at overlooks such as Cinnamon Bay, Trunk Bay and Caneel Bay looking out over Rockefeller Plantation and Hawksnest Bay. You'll have time to browse the charming shops and boutiques in Cruz Bay at the end of this island tour, before boarding the ferry back to your ship.

Note: This tour originates in St. Thomas and goes directly to St. John by an approximately 45-minute ferry ride each way.

Enjoy this amphibious tour bus for a land and water tour on beautiful St. Thomas. It's a narrated tour that combines fun and music with history and sightseeing. The adventure begins on this narrated sightseeing tour by cruising the waters along the Charlotte Amalie waterfront. This musical narrated tour goes by the famous castles of the pirates Bluebeard and Blackbeard and then by the historical Hassel Island. After passing Water Island the 'Duckaneer' becomes a boat and drives out of the water in Frenchtown. On land you'll travel through the Crown Bay cruise ship docks to Lindbergh Bay.

Approximate Duration: 1 ¼ hours

Level 1, Age & Weight Requirements

Experience the thrill of hot air ballooning, hang gliding and parachuting all in one, with Caribbean parasailing. See the gorgeous turquoise waters of the beautiful islands from a bird's eye view, 300 to 600 feet in the air. All take offs and landings are done directly from your towing vessel so you can stay high and dry or get wet and wild.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and weigh a minimum of 80 lbs. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Blackbeard's Island Experience

Approximate Duration: 6 ½ hours

Level 2, Family Recommended

Begin your day with a narrated, scenic ride along Skyline Drive. Once at Megan's Bay, considered one of the top beaches in the Caribbean, spend two hours on the half-mile long, heart-shaped beach swimming or just relaxing. Next, enter the age of Caribbean pirates at Blackbeard's Hill. Hike to the top of world-famous Blackbeard's Tower for a self-guided tour into the colonial-Victorian world. Explore lush tropical gardens, terraces with fountains, a 20-foot waterfall and the charming Hotel '1829.' Discover St. Thomas' unusual step streets, or frigangsas, as the Danes called them, including the famous 99 Steps. At your leisure, head for Main Street. Take a short walk down the famous 99 steps.

Note: Participants must be able to walk over uneven terrain and walk the 99 steps to downtown. At end of the tour you'll return to your ship at your own expense. Bring your swimsuit and a towel.

Sea Blaster Marine Snorkel

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

Board the vessel at the cruise ship dock and get ready to arrive at one of the best snorkel site locations in the Caribbean. This 70-foot powerboat was specifically designed for snorkel excursions offering a stern platform for extremely easy access in and out of the water, two private restrooms and fresh water showers. You'll have an exhilarating ride, sometimes wet, around the coast of St. Thomas and anchor at Fish Island, a beautiful cove between St. John and St. Thomas, to snorkel and swim in the crystal-clear warm Caribbean water. This tour is ideal for both beginners and advanced snorkelers. You'll view the spectacular coastline and beaches of the Virgin Islands and listen to Caribbean music. Level 2, Age Requirements

Experience the wonders of breathing underwater without a Scuba certification. After a short orientation and skills practice along the shoreline, you'll go on a guided underwater tour. The maximum depth is 20 feet which is perfect for fish watching and photographing the fragile coral formations and schools of tropical fish. There are no heavy tanks to carry, as your tanks float effortlessly above you. No prior snorkeling or diving experience is required, however, a few medical restrictions do apply.

Level 2, Age Requirements

Formed from a particularly beautiful type of crystallized limestone, this stunning cavern is undoubtedly one of the most spectacular natural attractions in the entire Caribbean. Though created over the course of hundreds of thousands of years, Harrison's Cave has only been accessible to the general public for some 24 years. After checking in at the Visitors Center, you board the electric tram that will take you down into the cave. As the driver pulls away, your guide will commence her commentary and you are on your way to a memorable experience – magnificent chambers, incredible stalactites and stalagmites, bubbling streams, tumbling cascades, plunging waterfalls and emerald pools. Throughout the almost mile-long cave, the flowstone covered walls glisten in the lights as the calcite-laden waters drip down from the roof. At various points the tram will stop to allow you to disembark and have a closer look at the beauty at hand. Just remember how long it has taken for these precious features to form and please do not touch them! One stop takes place at the lowest point in the cave, where a waterfall plunges into an emerald pool. Flash photography and videotaping are permitted, so take your camera.

Depending on the tide, the water may reach your horse's knees or belly. The ride concludes with a stroll along the beach before rejoining the inland trail back to the stables. After the ride, your host will transfer you back to the beach until it is time to return by bus to the pier.

Level 2, Family Recommended

The second dive is a tour of the stern, passing by several historical points of interest. Abundant marine life and encrusting coral make this excursion unforgettable.

Note: Participants must be at least 15 years of age and be comfortable walking approximately one mile. Alternate sites may be chosen due to weather and sea conditions. All equipment is provided.

Norman Island Snorkel

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2

Your boat will take you across the Sir Francis Drake Channel to Norman Island where you will snorkel The Caves or The Indians. You are guaranteed to see beautiful corals and sponges, plentiful fish, perhaps a turtle or ray will swim by and visit. After your snorkel, we stop ashore on Norman Island. Snorkel on a smaller nearby reef, wander ashore & explore the
