Tour Indicators/Symbols

Monte Carlo, Monaco

Due to the Grand Prix event taking place in May, coaches are not allowed to enter Monaco. For tours MCM_01, MCM_04, & MCM_09, transfers inside the Principality will be performed by local city bus and the return from Monaco Rock to your ship will include approximately 10 minutes of walking. This applies for the Norwegian Jade sailing dates of May 2nd, 9th, and 16th May, 2010.

NOTE: Casino de Monte Carlo opens its Salles Americaines (free admission) at 2.00pm, with slot machines only. Salles Publiques (entrance fee of 10 Euros in cash) is open at 2:00pm for Roulette and slot machines. Visitors must be at least 18 years of age and present a passport or ID Card. Morning tours to Monte Carlo will not be able to enter the Grand Casino. There is a free-admission, American-style casino at the Cafe de Paris, which opens at 10:00 am. Appropriate attire must be worn inside the Grand Casino: no shorts, tank tops, flip-flops, running shoes/sneakers are allowed inside the Grand Casino. The Casino will close for refurbishment from May 22nd, 2010 until further notice. November 1st is All Saints Day and most public offices, banks and shops are closed on that day. This applies to the Norwegian Jade sailing date of October 31st, 2010. Since this port of call is the first day of the cruise, we strongly recommend that you pre-book your tours for this port as space may be sold out once you get onboard.

Nice, Eze & Monaco

Approximate Duration: 7 ¾ hours

Level 2

Driving along the scenic Lower Corniche you'll reach the dazzling city of Nice that enjoys a privileged setting on the hill-framed curve of the Baie de Anges. Travel along the Promenade de Anglais, see the Russian Orthodox Church and take a walk around the fascinating old town with its narrow streets teeming with life. Reboard your coach for the drive to the Medieval village of Eze. You'll be dropped off at the general parking area in Eze and will have the choice to visit the perfume factory or to walk up the steep cobblestone streets of Eze where the alluring Medieval atmosphere will enchant you. Don't miss the magnificent views of the coast from the top before rejoining your coach to continue to the diamond, Monaco. Your coach will park at the foot of the rock, where you'll be carried to the top by escalators and elevators. On the upper level, enjoy a guided walking tour, passing by the main sights. After a short drive along the F1 circuit, you'll reach Monte Carlo where you'll start another walking tour that will bring you up (80 steps) to the square where you'll discover the well-known Grand Casino. Here you'll have some free time to take in the attractions of your choice around the Place du Casino before returning by motorcoach to your ship.

Guests must be able to walk over various surfaces with approximately 80 steps. Tour order may vary. Monaco Rock & Grimaldi Palace

Approximate Duration: 2 ¼ hours

Level 1

Tours of Monaco and Monte Carlo can involve a lot of walking but special arrangements have been made to use the local city buses to transfer you up to the old town, avoiding much of the walking. The narrow streets of Old Monaco and the Prince's Palace cling together on a promontory. You'll see the cathedral where Prince Rainier married Grace Kelly and where they are both now laid to rest. Your walking tour will bring you further to the Prince's Palace Square where you'll visit inside the Grimaldi Palace. After the changing of the guards and some free time for shopping, you'll have the option to return to the pier by city bus or you can choose to walk back on your own.

Note: During summer months expect extreme heat, crowded venues and long lines. We recommend that you dress in layers, wear comfortable shoes, a hat, sunglasses and bring bottled water. Guests must be able to walk approximately 1/2 mile over various surfaces. Tour order may vary. Due to the closure of the palace, this tour is not available for the Norwegian Jade sailing dates of October 31st, November 7th, and 14th, 2010. November 1st is All Saints Day and most public offices, banks and shops are closed on that day. This applies to the Norwegian Jade sailing date of July 4th, October 31st, 2010. Since this port of call is the first day of the cruise, we strongly recommend that you pre-book your tours for this port as space may be sold out once you get onboard.

Touring Monaco and Monte Carlo can involve a considerable amount of walking but special arrangements have been made to use local city buses to transfer you up to the old town and Monte Carlo to avoid much of the walking. The city bus will drive you directly up to the district of Monte Carlo, where you'll find the Place du Casino, the Hotel de Paris, Cafe de Paris and the legendary Monte Carlo Casino. View the exterior of the magnificent casino and take some time to stroll along the luxury boutiques and cafes. Reboarding the city bus you'll be driving up to Monaco Rock, where you'll walk the narrow streets of Old Monaco. Nice & Little Train

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1

Departing Monaco, an approximately 30-minute drive takes you along the Middle Corniche, one of the most scenic routes of the French Riviera, to arrive in Nice. You'll enter the city along the Promenade des Anglais, a splendid palm-lined boulevard stretching three miles along the Baie des Anges. Enjoy a walk on Cours Saleya, the elegant promenade of Old Nice, now lined with shops, restaurants, and the famous flower market held in these picturesque quarters (the Flower Market is closed on Mondays). Spend about 1 1/4 hours of free time to browse and enjoy Old Nice, before continuing back by coastal road to your ship in Monaco.

Level 3, Ultimate Touring, Family Recommended

Hike up to the volcano's crater and see the rivers of lava where crevices still exude fumes and heat. Vesuvius has erupted many times, but the eruption that stays in the mind of millions of people is the one in 79 A.D. Take in stunning views of Naples and the bay from the top. Time permitting, you'll visit a cameo factory near Pompeii.

Note: The steep gravel path to the crater is about 550 yards and takes approximately 40 minutes to walk round-trip. This tour is not recommended for guests with a history of heart disease or high blood pressure and does not include lunch. Guests should bring along local currency to purchase a snack outside of Pompeii. During summer months expect extreme heat, crowded venues and long lines. They are dedicated to a life of prayer, to working, and to welcoming pilgrims, making the site a place for dialogue, prayer and culture. Besides the monks, the Escolans also live in Montserrat who form the oldest boy's choir in Europe. During your stay and visit to Montserrat, you'll have a chance for an optional ride on the Funicular of San Juan which goes up to the panoramic point from where you'll admire beautiful views. Once you finish the visit you'll be driven to an NCL program hotel, Catalunya Square, the airport or ship.

From here, you'll continue your scenic drive along Passeig de Gracia, the best known boulevard in town. Your guide will point out two of Gaudi's masterpieces: Casa Batllo and Casa Mila. After your sightseeing drive, you'll enter the upper Eixample Area of Barcelona where the Sagrada Familia is situated. From the outside, your guide will explain all the details related to this unfinished church, which Gaudi planned with 3 monumental facades (one devoted to the Birth of Jesus Christ, one devoted to the Passion and one to the Glory). After seeing the intricate exterior of the massive cathedral, you'll drive to Pueblo Espanyol (a village built in 1929 representing squares and streets from all over Spain). In this mini replica of Spain, you'll head to the Andalusian Quarter where you'll find the Tablao de Carmen (named after the great dancer Carmen Amaya). Here you'll enjoy a flamenco show which is a unique dance style with heel stomping (taconeo) and hand clapping (palmas sordas). Once the show is finished, your tour will drop you off to an NCL program hotel, Catalunya Square or continue to the airport.

The City of Barcelona

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1

At first sight you'll see that Barcelona is a city with charming streets, busy people, and full of life. The old town, comprising of the Gothic Quarter, the Ribera and Raval Districts, are famed for historical monuments, narrow streets, and a Bohemian atmosphere; a perfect place for a stroll. The city also has the biggest selection of modernist architecture: a genuine open-air museum. Your tour takes you to the Sagrada Familia, passing through the Fisherman Area, the Columbus Monument, to the end of the famous promenade of La Rambla, which leads to Cataluna Square, considered the heart of the city. From here, you'll continue with a panoramic drive along the best-known boulevard in town, Passeig de Gracia. Along the way, your guide will point out some of the architectural masterpieces of Gaudi: La Pedrera House and Casa Batllo. Once you reach Diagonal Avenue you'll enter the area where the imposing Sagrada Familia Temple stands. From the outside, your guide offers an in-depth explanation of all the details related to the temple. The next famous site on your tour is Montjuic Hill, which was developed with trade fair halls, sports installations, parks and gardens which are to be found all over the mountain; today this is the most important recreational area in Barcelona. You'll pass through the Olympic Ring and stop at the Mirador del Alcalde for a photo opportunity. Continue to the Gothic Quarter where you'll see the 13th century cathedral. The cloister is an eclectic jumble of styles and lush vegetation where you can enjoy a relaxing walk through the Gothic Quarter. An infinite variety of history and art is ever present in the array of cobbled streets which always offer a changing and enriching vision of its many corners. Following your city tour, you'll be dropped off in Catalunya Square to enjoy Barcelona on your own. You'll be responsible for your transportation to the pier. Please allow sufficient time to return before the ship sails.

The Cathedral in the Gothic Quarter is closed to groups on Sundays. Your guide will give an explanation from outside and you will have the opportunity to enter individually on your own.
