## Victoria, British Columbia

Enchanting Butchart Gardens

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Justifiably renowned as Canada's 'City Of Gardens,' Victoria and its gardens burst into bloom year round. Today's outing will include an introduction to the historic downtown quarter and a visit to the famed Butchart Gardens. Departing Ogden Point your guide will point out Mile Zero, which is the western end of the Trans Canada Highway, Beacon Hill Park and Thunderbird Park. Later continue your drive to the Butchart Gardens, National Historic Site. Upon arrival your guide will provide you with a look into how the Butchart Family transformed the gardens from a barren rock quarry to what is now one of the world's best-known horticultural attractions. Multi-language maps help you conduct your self-guided tour of the colorful gardens. Later rejoin your local guide returning via Chinatown welcomed by the Gates of Harmonious Interest, and passing by Canada's narrowest street, Fan Tan Alley. Continue to the Inner Harbor framed by some of Canada's most recognizable landmarks, the majestic Parliament Buildings, the ivy-covered Empress Hotel prior to returning to the pier and your awaiting ship.

**Note:** Walking time and distance is at each guest's discretion. The gardens are stunning in the evening when illuminated by thousands of hidden lights. Garden illuminations offered when daylight hours shorten.

Victoria Highlights

Level 1, Family Recommended

Victoria is one of the most picturesque cities in North America, and exudes Old World charm and a distinctively British flair. This tour will show you the heart and soul of why so many visitors from around the world come each year to the City of Gardens. Starting at Ogden Point you'll head into the residential neighborhoods, complete with manicured lawns, abundant flowers of all shapes and sizes, and million dollar views of the Strait of Juan de Fuca and the Olympic Mountain range. Pass some of the highlights of Victoria, including views of Craigdarroch Castle, all that remains of the stately Dunsmuir estate. The tour will conclude at the Inner Harbor, the centerpiece of Victoria. This is the home of the Royal BC Museum, numerous street performers, craft vendors, food stalls, the BC Parliament Buildings, and the world famous Fairmont Empress Hotel.

Butchart Gardens & Victoria Highlights

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Enjoy the highlights of Victoria and a visit to the spectacular Butchart Gardens. Your guide will provide you with a look into how the Butchart Family transformed the gardens from a barren rock quarry to what is now one of the world's best-known horticultural attractions. The gardens are a lush paradise of flowers, rare trees and winding paths. Created over 100 years ago, this once-private garden is spectacular. When darkness falls, you'll be treated to an evening wonderland of lighting displays illuminating the gardens. Enjoy the cascading fountains and footbridges connecting you to the many themed gardens - including the beautiful Sunken Gardens, the Japanese Garden and the Rose Garden. Multi-language maps help you on your self-guided tour. As an added bonus, guests visiting on Saturdays in July and August will be treated to the Butchart Gardens fireworks display, choreographed to music.

**Note:** Order of sights may vary. Walking time and distance is at each guest's discretion. The gardens are stunning in the evening when illuminated by thousands of hidden lights. Garden illuminations offered when daylight hours shorten.

Craigdarroch Castle & Victoria Highlights

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 1

Departing Ogden Point, your guide will point out Mile Zero, the western end of the Trans Canada Highway, Beacon Hill Park and Thunderbird Park en route to Craigdarroch Castle an outstanding landmark home standing most affluent in a city steeped in heritage. Built between 1887-1890 by Robert Dunsmuir, Craigdarroch boasts a unique collection of residential stained and leaded glass, period furnishing and excellent wood paneling and carving. Enjoy your self-guided visit in the castle with docents available to answer any questions you may have. After your visit, rejoin your local guide returning via Chinatown and welcomed by the Gates of Harmonious Interest. Continue to the inner harbor framed by some of Canada's most recognizable landmarks, the majestic Parliament Buildings aglow in 3,333 light bulbs and the ivy-covered Empress Hotel. At the inner harbor and shopping district you'll be given free time to take in the local sights and sounds prior to your return journey to the pier and your awaiting ship.

**Note:** Must have good mobility and be able to negotiate over 90 stairs at the castle. Order of sights may vary. Use your complimentary shuttle ticket for your return to the pier. The shuttle operates every 20 minutes between the pier and downtown. Your guide will point out shuttle pick-up location to you. The shuttle schedule is dependent on prevailing local conditions, with the last shuttle departing downtown an hour prior to the ships departure from port. You can choose to remain with your guide and return directly to the pier.

Butchart Gardens, Wine & Chocolate

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

This experience is designed for the discerning traveler with a sense for some oenophile adventure. Enjoy an introduction to the city, explore Butchart Gardens, and partake in a unique opportunity pairing wine with chocolate at one of Victoria's finest wineries. Departing pier side, you'll pass by Beacon Hill Park, and a multifaceted inner harbor, a romantic and most photographed area. With views of a rolling landscape and farms en route, you'll arrive at Victoria's famed National Historic site, the Butchart Gardens, still owned by family descendants. The gardens began with a turn-of-the-century effort to beautify a quarry site and since its inception has grown into 55 acres with all the colors of nature. After a self-guided visit, rejoin your guide for a short drive to the winery. Partake in the pleasure of pairing wine with chocolate truffles, and this pleasure is deepened with knowledge shared by an interactive presentation allowing you to understand how to interpret all the information available to your senses of sight, smell and taste. Later you may independently taste ice-wine or simply browse the wine/gift shop.

Grand Victoria & Empress Tea

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 1

Welcome to Victoria, referred to as the 'City of Gardens'. Upon arriving at the Ogden Point Cruise Terminal facing the majestic Olympic Mountains to the south and the untamed wilderness of Vancouver Island to the north, you'll embark on a tour of old world charm. The grand tour of Victoria will bring you through the upscale neighborhoods, past stately homes with manicured lawns and gardens. This adventure will bring you to scenic viewpoints, affording you an opportunity to imagine the ambiance of living in one of North America's most scenic destination cities. The finale of this tour will be your arrival to the heart of Victoria with the Inner Harbor, Parliament Buildings and the ivy covered Fairmont Empress Hotel, one of the oldest and most famous hotels in Canada. Opened in 1908 and commonly known as The Empress, this is the site of the famous Empress High Tea. Served in their ornate Tea Lobby, the service includes tea served on Empress China, along with a Tea Tower laden with tea sandwiches, scones, preserves, cream and pastries. The Empress is a first-class experience, and requires a minimum of smart casual dress, although you may certainly feel free to 'dress to the nines' for this event.

Victoria has an excellent selection of pubs and microbreweries that are located all over downtown. On this tour, you'll experience truly Canadian hospitality, the unique atmosphere at each pub and beer flavors that are just as unique. This tour leaves the pier with an itinerary of two pubs and a micro-brewery. You'll be treated to samples of local beers plus an exclusive micro-brewery tour. Select beer samples at each location are included in the tour cost. A complimentary light appetizer will be provided at one of the three stops. Other food and beverage items may be purchased separately. Come meet the locals – you won't be disappointed!

Victoria by Horse-Drawn Trolley

Let us take you back to another time and experience Victoria at the pace of yesteryear. Your horse-drawn trolley waits, with blankets, to keep you warm in the cool evening breeze. The trolleys are drawn by two magnificent draught horses dressed in fine harnesses, and the passenger areas are covered to provide protection in the unlikely event of a summer shower. This guided tour heads out from the pier along the Victoria waterfront and then travels through the historic James Bay residential neighborhood winding our way back along the harbor with stunning views of the thousands of lights trimming the Legislative buildings.

**Note:** This is an open-air vehicle and we recommend you bring a jacket. Guests will need to navigate two steps to board the trolley and due to safety concerns, wheelchairs, walkers, strollers and scooters must be left at the departure location.

Victoria Walking Tour

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 2, Family Recommended

There are fewer cities more spectacularly suited for a walking tour than Victoria! This two hour excursion will start at the Ogden Point Cruise Terminal and head out along the seawall, lined with the well manicured lawns and gardens of those lucky enough to live with a view of the Strait of Juan De Fuca and the Olympic Mountain Range. Continue up towards Beacon Hill Park, with views of the famous Inner Harbor. From here you'll head down into the heart of town, full of shopping, restaurants, nightclubs and more. The Inner Harbor of Victoria is a bustling region with regular seaplane departures to the surrounding islands, street performers, local crafts, and food vendors. This is also the location of the Royal BC Museum, the British Columbia Parliament Buildings, and the world-famous Fairmont Empress Hotel, faced with century old ivy covered walls. Your guide will share with you the inside stories and history of the area, and the insiders knowledge unique to the City of Victoria.

You will tour Victoria on a charming old world style vintage Double Decker bus. Experience the old-world charm of this delightful capital city and its featured attractions. The Double Decker is designed to allow for plenty of photo opportunities, this tour winds through town to capture sights of Chinatown, Old Town, Beacon Hill Park, Marine Drive, Antique Row, Fisherman's Wharf, the majestic Legislative Buildings and the Inner Harbour.

**Note:** This tour is conducted on an open-air or open-top Vintage Double Decker bus. It is recommended that guests be prepared for inclement weather, wind, rain or cool temperatures by wearing or bringing a coat and hat especially in the spring and fall. We recommend you dress warmly in layers.

The downtown area remains walkable and multifaceted with century-old low-rise stone buildings, specialty shops, restaurants, pubs and a Chinatown that was the first in Canada. Multiple stops downtown will help you make the most of your experience.

**Note:** Tickets are valid all day. Service will run between the pier and town. Service will commence upon arrival and run until all aboard time.

## Astoria, Oregon

Historic Astoria & Fort Clatsop

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1

Consider yourself a modern day explorer as you board your bus for an exploration of the 'oldest American settlement west of the Rockies'. Join the ranks of important visitors starting with Captain Robert Gray in 1792, Lewis and Clark's corps of discovery in 1805, and now you. Take a tour of the Astoria Column with its breathtaking view over Astoria, the Columbia River and the Megler Bridge all the way to Washington. Tour Fort Clatsop, a replica of the fort as depicted in Clark's journal. On the return to Astoria, you'll pass Famous Union Town, the Doughboy monument and the beautiful Victorian homes of historic Astoria, before arriving at the acclaimed Columbia River Maritime Museum, designated Oregon's official State Maritime Museum. This outstanding institution with 24,000 square feet of exhibit space was the first nationally accredited maritime museum in the western United States.

**Note:** The order of tour stops and scenic drive routes may vary to avoid congestion. The type of transportation used for this tour is a school bus. There are 160 stairs to the top of the Astoria Column.

Seaside & Cannon Beach

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1

Visit some of Oregon's most enchanting communities. Seaside is a family resort area where families have been spending the summers for decades. Seaside offers excellent seafood restaurants, quaint shops and friendly people. Cannon Beach, once an artist community and now a Mecca for photographers, artists and writers, offers several galleries and shops. A great photo-op will be enjoyed as you stop to see Haystack Rock, the third-tallest freestanding monolith in the world.

Step back in time with a visit to the elegant Victorian Astoria Flavel Home built in 1885 by Captain George Flavel, a Columbia River bar pilot and the area's first millionaire. The Flavel House is a magnificent example of Queen

Anne style architecture with period furnishing and artwork. The Flavel House sits on a park-like setting covering an entire city block. This beautiful Victorian mansion has been returned to its original form by experts in historic restoration. Its decorative exterior, with hipped roof, balconies and verandas, is distinguished by a fourth-story cupola used by Captain Flavel and his wife to watch the river traffic. As you walk through this historic home with its 14-foot ceilings and elegant woodwork, you'll discover furnishings and decor typical of a century ago. Other fine examples of the wood worker's crafting are the six hand-carved fireplaces mantles, all carved from different hardwoods. After the tour, relax in the parlor for a treat of tea and scones.

Ultimate Oregon Coast

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

The northern Oregon coast pulses with a rich and varied habitat. The coastal communities also have an equally rich and diverse history that is steeped in maritime heritage, timber and pioneer settlements. From Astoria to Tillamook you'll make new discoveries at iconic sites that include the Tillamook Air Museum, the Tillamook Cheese Factory and the Nehalem Bay Winery. At the Tillamook Air Museum, hanger 'B' built in 1943 has been home to one of the finest collections of privately owned WW II flying aircraft. The Tillamook Cheese Factory is a farmer-owned cooperative that was established in 1909. Tillamook ice cream is limited to the Pacific Northwest and offers more than 40 flavors of ice cream. Nehalem Bay Winery is a place to enjoy the handcrafted wines of specific wine growing appellations in Oregon. You'll participate in a more intimate wine experience by visiting this small and more personal winery, which is located in an old 'creamery'. The folks who create Oregon wine are families, farmers and good stewards of the land. Nehalem Bay wines are truly handcrafted reflections of the wine maker and the land, produced in small lots rather than corporate quantities. Don't just plan a tour – plan your next adventure along the Pacific shores rugged coastline to enjoy the Tillamook Air Museum, the Tillamook Cheese Factory and the Nehalem Bay Winery.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 21 years of age to be able to enjoy the wine tasting at the Nehalem Bay Winery. The order of tour stops and scenic drive routes may vary to avoid congestion.

Astoria Ale Trail

Beer Lovers will be delighted by the variety of local brews available in the Astoria area. To taste a number of the varieties, microbrew fanatics will visit tasting rooms opened by local brewing companies and sample the many Oregon favorites. You'll visit some local breweries in town on a personalized tour complete with samples and a glass of beer of your choice at each pub. After this ale trail tour, you'll have a better understanding of the art of the beer brewing in Oregon.

Columbia Maritime Museum & Vistas

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2

Join us as we explore and celebrate the lives of the men and women who work this treacherous coast every day. You'll meet your driver/guide dockside and head through the heart of downtown Astoria on your way to the Columbia River Maritime Museum. This interactive facility will show you the past, present and future of life at 'The Bar', as the mouth of the Columbia is known to seafarers. Enjoy a narrative video of the river upon entering, and take the chance to try on foul weather gear, tie a few knots, or sit in the Captain's chair of a ship's bridge exhibit. Also on site is an actual ship that was used as a 'floating lighthouse' off the coast. From here you'll head up the hill overlooking the town to the Astoria Column, which looks out above the Columbia River and offers an unparalleled view of the town. You can climb to the top of the tower, but it's not for the faint of heart, as it boasts an astounding 160 stairs in a circular staircase climbing up the center of the tower, with no elevator access. On the way back to your ship, keep your eyes open for Hollywood filming locations used in such classics as the Goonies, Kindergarten Cop, Short Circuit, and the Free Willy films.

**Note:** The Park at Astoria Column is accessible for wheelchairs; however access to the top of the Column is not accessible by wheelchair. For details, please consult your Shore Excursion staff before booking. There are 160 stairs to the top of the Astoria Column.

Scenic Astoria

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Guests with Disabilities

Astoria, Oregon is situated at the mouth of the mighty Columbia River, the end point of the Lewis and Clark expedition and one of the most picturesque ports on the west coast of the United States. Hollywood has recognized the beauty of the area and has for years considered it a prime filming spot for classics such as the Goonies, Kindergarten Cop, Short Circuit, and the Free Willy films. After arriving in Astoria, you'll meet your driver/guide on the dock to embark on this approximate four hour tour. From the pier, you'll travel to the Astoria Column. This tower built on a hill above the city looks out above the Columbia River and offers an unparalleled view of the town. You're welcome to climb to the top of the tower, but it's not for the faint of heart as it boasts an astounding 160 stairs in a circular staircase climbing up the center of the tower, with no elevator access. After this wonderful photo stop, head out on the coastal highway to Fort Stevens, situated right at the mouth of the Columbia River and known to seafarers as 'The Bar'. Here you'll have the chance to walk on the beach while viewing remnants of shipwrecks that scatter across the coast in one of the most dangerous navigational areas in the world. From here it's just a short drive to Fort Clatsop, where the Lewis and Clark party wintered once arriving at the Pacific. Tour the Visitor Center and the actual fort where the expedition lived. Explore the trails, freshwater springs and forest where Sacagawea walked, and see examples of the style of dugout canoe that was used to descend the Columbia.

**Note:** The Park at Astoria Column is accessible for wheelchairs; however access to the top of the Column is not accessible by wheelchair. For details, please consult your Shore Excursion staff before booking. There are 160 stairs to the top of the Astoria Column.

Lighthouse Tour

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1

Welcome to the mouth of the Columbia River, one of the most feared and treacherous navigable waterways in the world. Seafarers refer to the area as 'The Bar', where the mouth of the mighty river meets the Pacific Ocean. Come join us as we explore the rugged coast and two of the lighthouses of the Columbia. Depart for Cape Disappointment, home to a Visitor Center and viewing gallery of the sheer cliffs and tumultuous ocean. After a brief introduction from a ranger, explore this interactive gallery chronicling the areas history from the Lewis and Clark Expedition to modern shipping. See the lighthouse that keeps unknowing ships from becoming one more statistic of this deadly coastline. From here head to the North Head Lighthouse just a bit further up the coast. This remote facility is home to the Ranger staff, and boasts a 1/4 mile flat and even trail to the lighthouse itself. Remember to bring your camera, as this location is situated on an overlook with impressive views of both sandy beaches and rugged cliffs.

## San Francisco, California

City Tour with Dim Sum Lunch

Approximate Duration: 5 ½ hours

Level 1, Meal

Your tour begins with a drive along the Embarcadero by the Ferry Building towards downtown San Francisco. Continue on to Union Square and then head toward the famous Nob Hill for a photo stop and a visit to Grace Cathedral. Continue to the Civic Center and view City Hall. Then it's on to Chinatown for a Dim Sum lunch at one of Chinatown's popular restaurants. After lunch, ride through the streets of North Beach, Fisherman's Wharf, and Ghirardelli Square and by the Palace of Fine Arts. A photo opportunity is waiting at Vista Point, just across the world-famous Golden Gate Bridge. Then it's on to Golden Gate Park and Alamo Square (time permitting) before returning to your ship.

Muir Woods & Sausalito

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 2

Across the bay, San Francisco is known for its beautiful landscape. On this tour, you'll explore the town of Sausalito and have the opportunity to visit Muir Woods, a 550-acre national monument and home to towering coastal redwoods including some of the tallest and oldest trees in the world.
