Tour Indicators/Symbols

Level 1:	Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
Level 2:	Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.

San Juan, Puerto Rico

San Juan City Tour & Bacardi Distillery

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Age Requirements

Leaving the pier by air-conditioned minibus or motorcoach, you'll visit the Bacardi Museum where you'll learn of the age-old process of producing this fine rum and the Bacardi family history. Most importantly you'll get to enjoy a sample of this popular drink. The distillery also boasts a beautiful park and grounds for you to explore. The tour continues to what is known as New San Juan, a modern city which will show you the Condado Area with its luxurious resort hotels and casinos. Drive through Old San Juan where you'll view the massive, ancient fortresses and great stonewalls that has protected the capital city since they were built by the Spanish Conquistadors in the 16th century. Takes pictures at Plaza Colon of the San Cristobal Fortress considered the largest fort ever built and the surroundings. Enjoy the historical sites of the Old City.

Note: Participants must be at least 21 years of age to sample alcoholic beverages and present a valid ID. Bacardi is a popular site; for this reason extended wait time may be experienced. Bring adequate sun protection and wear comfortable walking shoes. Traffic in old and new San Juan can be very congested. Alternate routes are used whenever possible. Some of the stops are unguided allowing participants to browse on their own.

ATV Adventure

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Encounter a unique experience within the foothills of El Yunque on this guided tour. The ride takes you through the foothills of the rainforest and the spectacular scenery of Puerto Rico's east coast. Upon arrival, riders will be given an introduction and safety instructions on how to ride and operate the ATV. The adventure begins as you follow the experienced guides along trails designed for these ATV's. The tracks are carefully laid out for your safety. Enjoy different terrains that will take you along the forest. Whether you're an experienced rider or a first time rider, you can be sure of an exhilarating and adventurous ride!

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age. Drivers must be at least 18 years of age, in good health and provide a valid driver's license and weigh no more than 260 lbs. Maximum combined weight is 450 lbs. All participants on this tour are required to complete a waiver and/or release form disclosing any medical conditions. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or guests with back or neck injuries. ATV accommodates two passengers – one driver and one rider. Those wishing to be a passenger/rider on the ATV must be accompanied by a driver and must book on board the ship at the Shore Excursion Desk. Wear your swimsuit, closed-toe shoes and bring a towel. ATV's used are Bombardier four track models. Helmet use is mandatory and is provided along with goggles. Swimming in the river is subject to weather and the river's condition.

Catamaran Sailaway

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

The tour begins with a bus ride departing from the Old San Juan port to the most northeasterly point of the island. Along the way, you will leave behind the town of Rio Grande housing the only Rainforest in the United States, El Yunque National Rainforest. Experience the panoramic views of one of the famous beaches in Puerto Rico - Luquillo Beach. When you arrive at Puerto Del Rey Marina the friendly staff will greet you as you board the catamaran and head west until the sun dips below the horizon. This tour takes you around a cay of emerald islands just off the marina. Music ranging from Calypso to Reggae sets the mood. Go below deck to observe the ocean life zone. At twilight, starry skies or moonlight glow.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age. All non-alcoholic drinks and snacks are included. Nature and environmental issues may include absence of sunset, wind, rain, currents causing delays on the setting and departure times.

Canopy Adventure

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 3, Age, Weight & Height Requirements

Board your air-conditioned transportation for the approximately 30-minute transfer to the municipality of Guaynabo. The lush green tropical forests that surround Guaynabo provide a biological paradise of rich diversity and profusion of tropical fauna. The canopy adventure gives you a chance to see this world from a unique perspective. With the assistance of an experienced guide, you can sail from tree to tree and platform to platform on a network of pulleys and horizontal cables that are mounted between 10 and 70 feet above the tropical forest floor. The adventure consists of observation platforms, 8 horizontal traverses, including a rappel, a fascinating vertical descent. You will have a knowledgeable guide to assist you every step of the way, from when you leave the ground, until you return to the forest floor.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age. Minimum height is 48" tall. Maximum weight 250 lbs. We recommend you wear comfortable clothing that you don't mind getting dirty and closed-toed shoes. This tour is not recommended for women who are pregnant or those with heart trouble, seizure disorders, problems with balance, or back and neck disabilities. All participants on this tour are required to complete a waiver and/or release form. This excursion is for guests that are active, in excellent health and very good physical condition. Safety equipment (harness, gloves and helmet) are provided and must be worn at all times. This tour includes extended periods of physical exertion, extensive walking and climbing. There are numerous steps, inclines, cobblestones, and other rough terrain. The air conditioning on bus could be temporarily discontinued when bus travels up the mountain.

Mountain Bike Adventure

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 3, Age & Weight Requirements

Get ready to pedal your way through the foothills of Puerto Rico's El Yunque Rainforest in an exhilarating bike ride into the heart and soul of the island. After an approximate 45-minute drive to Hacienda Carabali, riders will be greeted by specialized and certified guides who will instruct the group on safety and distribute the aluminum bicycles, helmets and gloves to the group. Then the real adventure begins as you follow your experienced guides along outlined trails into the foothills of the rainforest. During this thrilling two-hour adventure, riders are introduced to the diverse flora and fauna of Puerto Rico. A stop at the banks of the Mameyes River is made. During this time you may dive into the fresh and clear waters of the river and relax. After this well-earned break, get back on your bike and continue the journey through the rainforest.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and in good physical condition. Maximum weight 250 lbs. We recommend you wear your bathing suit under comfortable clothing and bring a towel if you plan on swimming in the river. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or guests with back or neck injuries. Water and snacks will be provided. All participants on this tour are required to complete a waiver and/or release form disclosing any medical conditions. Proximity to the water and swimming will be subject to weather conditions.

San Juan City Tour

Approximate Duration: 2 ½ hours

Level 2

Board your air-conditioned minibus or motorcoach and drive through historic Old San Juan, viewing its many landmarks. A stop is made at the San Cristobal the towering fortress built by the Spanish between 1634 and 1771. Here you can take in the views of the city and its surrounding area. A drive through the Old City lets you see such landmarks as Plaza Colon, Alejandro Tapia Theater and the different Spanish architecture in Old San Juan. Then head for New San Juan, passing the Condado resort area and Isla Verde district. Enjoy a brief stop for shopping before returning to the ship.

Note: We recommend you wear comfortable walking shoes, bring a hat and sunscreen. Due to walking required at the fort, the activity level is substantial. The fort is not wheelchair accessible. There is a steep ramp to access the fort (about 65 paces one way). The first level features the barracks, gun rooms, and video presentation. The next level requires walking up another steep ramp (about 35 paces one way). To access the third level observation ports for the best views of the city requires going up another steep ramp (about 65 paces one way). Some of the stops are unguided allowing guests to browse on their own. Traffic in old and new San Juan can be congested. Alternate routes are implemented whenever possible.

Bioluminescence Bay Kayak

Approximate Duration: 5 ¾ hours

Level 3, Age & Weight Requirements

Take an approximate 1½ hour trip to Fajardo where you'll enjoy the views before arriving in Fajardo for your adventurous Bioluminescence Bay Kayak tour. Under the blanket of the night sky and the Fajardo Light House marvel at the water, rich in bioluminescent organisms. The magic begins as you enter the lagoon and dip your hands or paddle into the waters, causing thousands of bioluminescent organisms to glow. Your guide will provide an informative narration of your surroundings as you kayak through this tranquil environment.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and in good health with no arm, back or neck problems. There is a weight restriction of 400 lbs. combined 2 persons per kayak. We recommend you wear your bathing suit or comfortable clothing with sandals and bring a towel. All participants on this tour are required to complete a waiver and/or release form disclosing any medical conditions. This tour is not recommended for guests with any type of back or heart problems or pregnant. Tour includes use of a double kayak, paddles, life jackets, safety equipment, lights, and a bottle of water. The transfer to the kayak put-in point is escorted but un-narrated. The professional guides meet you upon arrival in Fajardo. As this excursion operates in the evening, visibility can be limited. Guests are discouraged from bringing non-waterproof cameras or any other items that they wish not to get wet. Transfer time may vary due to traffic.

St. Thomas, US Virgin Islands

Tour Code: STT_01

Coral World Ocean Park

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2, Family Recommended

From the three-story Observatory Tower built right into the ocean, descend below the sea to view the diverse marine life. The mid-level of the tower houses a 50,000-gallon predator tank, home to sharks, barracuda and moray eels. The park has several large outdoor pools where you can get close to baby sharks, stingrays, turtles, and a pool where you can touch a variety of invertebrates. You'll also have an opportunity to visit the Marine Gardens, where its 21 aquariums will provide you with an up-close view of the unusual behaviors and organisms of the Caribbean reef. After a while in the park, feel free to follow the boardwalk to Coki Beach, to snorkel and view the tame fish in shallow water or just soak up some sun!

Note: Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Screamin' Eagle Jet Boat

Approximate Duration: 1 hour

Level 2, Age & Height Requirements

This awesome 700 HP turbo-charged jet boat will take you on an incredible high-speed harbor and coastline tour for 40 minutes of fun and excitement. You'll experience a mixture of fun, beautiful scenery, crystal-clear waters, warm sea spray and exhilarating speed along with breathtaking 180-degree spins. The Screamin' Eagle is the sightseeing thrill-ride of a lifetime.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and at least 4 feet tall. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. This tour is not recommended for guests with any type of back or heart problems or pregnant.

The Best of St. Thomas

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Board your open-air safari bus and travel along the scenic east coast of St. Thomas to Sapphire Overlook where you can take in the views of the neighboring islands. Then it's on to Beacon Point, which offers breathtaking island views from the observation platform. Stop at Skyline overlook to see the historic harbor of Charlotte Amalie 800 feet above your cruise ship. Next, enjoy views of heart-shaped, palm-fringed Megan's Bay (one of the top 10 beaches in the world) from Drake's Seat before continuing to St. Peter Great House and Botanical Gardens, once the haunt of the rich and famous. This is a magnificent Caribbean estate, featuring stunning views, classic Caribbean architecture and vintage furnishings in a beautiful, tropical setting. Enjoy a refreshing complimentary rum or fruit punch and stroll the lush grounds, perched 1,000 feet above the ocean that is home to more than 100 varieties of tropical fauna. This is a 'must see' in the Caribbean. Choose a complimentary souvenir gift as a remembrance of your excursion.

Note: Guests ending the tour in Charlotte Amalie are responsible for their taxi fare back to the ship. Tours departing in the afternoon do not have the option of remaining in Charlotte Amalie for shopping. There are steps at St. Peter Great House. The Botanical Nature Trail includes two flights of stairs down and two flights of stairs back up. Mountain Top has a flat entry and easy access for those who are mobility impaired.

St. John Beach Escape

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Escape to the most pristine of the U.S. Virgin Islands – beautiful St. John. At Charlotte Amalie (or Havensight), you'll board a ferry for a short cruise through Pillsbury Sound to the island of St. John. Upon arrival, you'll board an open-air safari taxi for a relaxing ride to Trunk Bay, considered one of the most beautiful beaches in the world. Along the way, you'll have the opportunity to view and photograph spectacular sights alongside the Caribbean Sea. Stops include the Cruz Bay overlook, Caneel Bay and Hawksnest Bay. Enjoy approximately one-and-a-half hours at beautiful Trunk Bay to swim, snorkel, sunbathe, or just relax under swaying palm trees. Afterward, you'll reboard your transport and take a short trip back to Cruz Bay, where you can do a little shopping as you wait for the scenic return ferry cruise to St. Thomas.

St. John Eco Hike & Beach

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

A scenic and narrated ferry boat ride brings you to the charming, quaint town of Cruz Bay on St. John Island. From the Virgin Islands National Park Visitor Center, begin your hike along a hillside trail offering scenic tropical ocean views of nearby islands. Your nature guide will share stories about the flora and fauna of the islands along with cultural and historical information. Arriving at Honeymoon Beach, you'll find a picturesque palm-fringed beach with crystal-clear waters edged with colorful coral reefs. Enjoy a refreshing swim at this unforgettable beach and relax in the soft sand under the shade of coconut trees. The trail continues to Caneel Bay's colorful botanical gardens. Experience the ruins of an 18th century Danish sugar plantation and factory. A scenic safari bus tour along the north shore Virgin Islands National Park Drive returns you to Cruz Bay. Join your ferry for an exciting ride to return to the Port of Charlotte Amalie in St. Thomas.

Note: Participants must be at least 7 years of age, weigh no more than 275 lbs., in good physical condition and able to walk over uneven terrain in a tropical climate. Wear your swimsuit, bring a towel, sunscreen and bottled water. We recommend you wear sturdy shoes suitable for hiking. Ferry is an approximately 45-minute ride each way.

Downtown Shopping & Magen's Bay Beach

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

After approximately two hours of bargain shopping in the quaint town of Charlotte Amalia 'downtown', meet up with your driver at a prearranged time and place for the transfer back to your ship. Store your bags in your stateroom and hurry back – in 30 minutes you'll reboard your vehicle for a scenic ride to Magen's Bay Beach. Acclaimed as one of the ten most beautiful beaches in the world by National Geographic Society, Magen's Bay is an ideal place for the getaway portion of your visit to St. Thomas. Enjoy a scenic drive, by open-air safari bus to Drake's Seat, a breathtaking vantage point which offers a commanding view of Magen's Bay and surrounding islands from which Sir Francis Drake himself once viewed his fleet. From there, it's on to Magen's Bay, for approximately two hours to experience the crystal-clear waters, white-sand beaches, and spectacular palm fringed coastline. Enjoy swimming, sunbathing, beachcombing, and just plain old relaxing before the return drive to your ship.

Note: Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel and sunscreen. Guests must be able to step up 2-3 steps into vehicle with limited assistance. A credit card may be required for rentals and food concession. Restroom facilities are available both downtown and at the beach.

On the beach there are showers and restroom facilities and snack bar.

Visit St. Peter Great House a wonderful Caribbean Estate featuring stunning views of the US and British Virgin Islands from 1,000 feet above the sea. Continue on to Drake's Seat and gaze below at the crystalline waters of Megan's Bay Beach, named one of the top 10 beaches in the world by National Geographic. The next stop is at the Skyline Overlook, for an amazing view of the historic St Thomas Harbor and your ship nested below. Relax on the ride down to the capital of Charlotte Amalie, a duty-free shopping paradise, where bargains await you on jewelry, electronics,

Soak up the views on the scenic Skyride to Paradise Point. The Skyride takes you approximately 700 feet above sea level to one of the most amazing views in the Caribbean. Enjoy a panoramic vista of the harbor, cruise ships and the hillside town of Charlotte Amalie. The round-trip Skyride ride is 15 minutes, allowing plenty of time at the top to relax with a frozen drink or lunch. The Skyride is located directly across the street from the Havensight Mall. Come at your leisure, as the Skyride runs continuously.

Kayak, Hike & Snorkel of Cas Cay

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

Experience the St. Thomas Mangrove Wildlife Refuge & Marine Sanctuary. The nature guides will explain the ecosystem during a rest stop while kayaking to the deserted island. After finding a hermit crab village, discover breathtaking volcanic cliffs and the impressive Red Point Blow Hole. Then, snorkel in the clear, protected waters of the coral-fringed mangrove nursery and over the remnants of a shipwreck. Look for iguanas, pelicans, rays, octopus, barracuda, and colorful reef fish.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age, weigh no more than 275 lbs. and must be able to get in and out of kayaks unassisted. Snorkel equipment, a snack and beverage is included. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

St. John Island Tour

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Upon arriving in St. John, you'll view some of the most wonderful sights in the Caribbean, including white-sand beaches, crystal-clear waters and island views of the British Virgin Islands. You'll also see Cinnamon Bay, one of the last working plantations on St. John. Back along the north shore coast road you'll stop at overlooks such as Cinnamon Bay, Trunk Bay and Caneel Bay looking out over Rockefeller Plantation and Hawksnest Bay. You'll have time to browse the charming shops and boutiques in Cruz Bay at the end of this island tour, before boarding the ferry back to your ship.

Note: This tour originates in St. Thomas and goes directly to St. John by way of an approximately 45-minute ferry ride each way.

All take offs and landings are done directly from your towing vessel so you can stay high and dry or get wet and wild.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and weigh a minimum of 80 lbs. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. This tour is not recommended for guests with any type of back or heart problems or who are pregnant.

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

Sit back and enjoy a relaxing sail to Shipwreck Cove at Buck Island aboard our beautiful 65-foot sailing catamaran, 'Castaway Girl', a fast and stable vessel, affording spacious sunbathing decks and a large, comfortable cockpit for those preferring the shade. After an exhilarating sail on the crystal-clear waters of the Caribbean, the Captain will drop anchor off magnificent Buck Island where our friendly, experienced crew will provide snorkeling instructions and any assistance you may need. As our crew snorkel along with you, you'll have ample time to observe a sunken shipwreck, brilliant coral reefs and tropical fishes. While listening to some wonderful music, enjoy complimentary rum smoothies, sodas and water, along with dry snacks, during the relaxing sail back to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and able to get in and out of the water and up the easy boarding ladder unaided. All snorkelers must wear safety snorkel vests, which are provided.

Wreck of the Rhone Certified Scuba

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements, C-Card
