- You must have a GED or High School Diploma
- You must be legally authorized to work in the U.S. and qualify for a U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC) as well as a Transportation Workers Identification Credential (TWIC).
- In order to qualify for a MMC you must:
  - ✓ Be at least 18 years of age
  - ✓ Be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident Alien
  - ✓ Pass Physical Exam/Drug Screen
  - ✓ Have a clear background

## REGISTRATION & RESUME:

- ✓ Candidate's must complete an **on-line registration form** prior to attending the event.
